Nationally-ranked W&J was idle this week ... The Presidents return to action at home this Saturday against Hanover at 2 p.m.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's game on Saturday against Wooster was postponed due to the terrorist attacks ... No make-up date was scheduled ... Grove City is idle again this Saturday - the Wolverines return to the gridiron on Saturday, Sept. 29 for their PAC opener at Thiel.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg offense was limited to just 150 total yards, while only recording one first down in the first half of the Yellow Jackets' 27-0 home loss to Ohio Wesleyan ... Senior QB Tom Naughton threw for 126 yards (14 for 30) while only playing in the second half, due to violation of team rules ... Ohio Wesleyan's Matt Capone rushed for 184 yards on 18 carries, including a 63-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter ... Waynesburg's All-PAC tight end **Don Frazier** did not play due to a shoulder injury ... Waynesburg running back Rocky Doman, who averaged 115 yards in two games, was limited to just nine yards ... Waynesburg's school-record streak of 47 consecutive games of scoring was snapped.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped to 0-3 on the season this weekend in Bluffton, Ohio, as a 42-yard field goal as time expired gave Bluffton College a 23-20 victory over the Tomcats ... Thiel scored two fourth quarter touchdowns to tie the game at 20-20 with 2:18 to play, before Bluffton moved the ball to the Tomcat 25-yard line to set up the game-winning field goal with no time outs and the clock running ... The Beavers got the snap off for the attempt with only one second remaining on the clock.

Westminster Titans

Westminster improved to 1-1 by topping Geneva 12-7 in the Beaver County Rotary Classic in Beaver Falls on Saturday Both Westminster scores came on interception returns for touchdowns, one by senior ILB Eric Witt (30 yards) and one by junior CB Joe Stern (98 yards to close the first half)... The Titans won despite being limited to five first downs and 53 vards of total offense ... Senior DE Joe Bianco was named Defensive Player of the Game for the Rotary Classic after posting 11 tackles and four quarterback sacks, including three on the game's final drive after Geneva had reached the Titan 19-yard line in the final two minutes ... The Titans broke Geneva's fourgame win streak in the series.

West Liberty State at Westminster (1-1)

Series Record: Westminster leads 3-0

Game Notes: Westminster hosts the West Liberty State Hilltoppers, who were 8-2 and co-champions of the NCAA Division II West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) in 2000 ... The Titans gave the Hilltoppers one of their two losses a year ago by posting a 17-6 decision at Wheeling Island Stadium in Wheeling, W.Va. ... Westminster forced five Hilltopper turnovers last year to win in a driving rainstorm ... The Titans won the only meeting between the two schools at Burry Stadium 13-7 in 1996 ... All three Westminster touchdowns this season have been scored by the Titan defense.
