Bethany Bison

Bethany junior goalkeeper **Ryann Bradley** stopped three shots each in shut-out wins over LaRoche and Lake Erie ... Senior midfielder **Shey McGuire** had three assists last week ... Senior forward **Stuart Bracher** tallied four goals and one assist ... He connected on a penalty kick to clinch the LaRoche win, and came back with a natural hat trick against Lake Erie ... Bracher also assisted on the Bison's only goal in W&J loss.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J men's soccer team finished a 2-0 week with their first-ever win over Bethany, dating back to 1970 ... The Presidents were winless in the previous 33 chances (0-32-1) ... Freshman forward **Mike Chiodo** tallied hat tricks in both W&J victories this weekend, while junior forward **Tom Cameron** added a hat trick against Lake Erie on Saturday ... W&J is outscoring opponents, 18-6, this season, including a 10-3 edge in the first half ... The Presidents are holding opponents to 1.5 goals per game.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City held top-ranked and defending national champion Messiah scoreless through the first half, but fell 2-0 ... Messiah had beaten its previous two opponents by 8-0 finals ... GCC dealt Messiah one of its two defeats in its 2000 NCAA Division III national championship season (22-2-1) ... Junior goalkeeper **Brad Smith** recorded his 10th career shutout with four saves in the league opener against Waynesburg, then made 10 saves against Messiah.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg fell to 0-4 on the season this week, as the Yellow Jackets dropped their PAC opener to Grove City 2-0 before falling 1-0 to Pitt-Bradford.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats were 1-2 last week, topping D'Youville 4-1 while falling to Pitt-Greensburg (3-0) and Pitt-Bradford (2-1 in double overtime) ... Senior **Michael Perry** scored two goals in the D'Youville win.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's soccer team remained unbeaten on the season on Saturday, as the Titan kickers celebrated their home opener with a 5-0 non-conference shutout of visiting Pitt-Greensburg ... Westminster jumped on top in the game's third minute on a goal by sophomore forward **Todd Fisher** ... Fisher made it 2-0 with his team-best fifth goal of the year in the 68th minute, assisted by junior **Pasquale Reino** ... Reino scored two minutes later, giving the Titans a 3-0 lead. Westminster closed the scoring with late goals by junior **Joe Brickner** and freshman **Mark Rhoads** ... Junior **Kevin Humberston** went the distance in goal, stopping 12 shots for his first shutout.
