ANDY SHOCKEY Grove City College

Senior Sweeper - Mechanicsburg, Pa./Cumberland Valley H.S.

Shockey anchored the Grove City defense which posted shutouts over PAC rival Waynesburg (1-0) and Mount Union (2-0) last week, holding the two teams to a combined six shots. He has helped lead the Wolverines to their best start (4-1) since the 1996 season.

Also nominated was junior forward **Justin Kosta** of Bethany, freshman forward **Andy Komar** of Washington & Jefferson and senior forward **Brian Zombec** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

Bethany posted an 8-0 victory over Thiel in its only action of the week ... Sophomore Daniel Reinoso scored the gamewinning goal against Thiel 40 seconds into the match, while later assisting on another goal ... Junior Justin Kosta assisted on the first two goals for the Bison, then scored the third goal as Bethany took a 3-0 lead into halftime ... Sophomore Jimmy Hershner scored a pair of second half goals.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J men's soccer team split a pair of contests last week, dropping a 2-0 non-conference contest to Penn State-Behrend on Thursday before rebounding with a 2-0 PAC win over Thiel on Saturday ... PS-B stooped 12 W&J shots on Thursday to post the shutout ... Freshman Andy Komar and senior Josh Jeffries supplied the goals for the Presidents against Thiel, who improved to 2-0 in the PAC with the victory ... Komar now has three goals and one assist for seven points in his rookie campaign.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines posted shutouts of PAC rival Waynesburg (1-0) and Mount Union (2-0) this week, giving Grove City four shutouts in its first five games ... At 4-1, Grove City is off to its best start since the 1996 season when it opened 7-0 ...Sophomore forward Dustin King netted his third game-winning goal of the season on Saturday against Mount Union ... Grove City outshot its opponents 44-6 last week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After falling to 0-5 with a 1-0 PAC loss to Grove City, the Waynesburg men's soccer team rallied with non-conference road wins at Hilbert (5-0) and at D'Youville (4-1) over the weekend ... Sophomore goalkeeper Justin Fee recorded 18 saves (allowing only one goal) in the two weekend wins ... Senior forward Brian Zombek scored four goals and tallied three assists for 11 points this week, including a hat trick in the Jackets' 5-0 win at Hilbert.

The Tomcats have dropped three straight games after PAC losses to Bethany (8-0) and Washington & Jefferson (2-0) last week.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's soccer team remained unbeaten on the seasonon Saturday, as the Titan kickers posted a 2-0 road win at La Roche ... The 4-0 start marks the best start in school history ... Sophomore forward Matthew Roser scored the opening goal of the game against La Roche in the 75th minute (assisted by **James Green**), then assisted on the second goal by freshman midfielder John Booth in the 80th minute ...
