PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

STUART BRACHER Bethany College

Senior Forward - Galston, Scotland/Loudon Academy H.S.

Bracher scored both goals in Bethany's only game of the week, a 2-1 overtime win over Penn State-Behrend. His first goal came on a penalty kick in th 79th minute to tie the game. He hit the game-winner in the 11th minute of the first overtime. Bracher now has 64 career goals at Bethany, just three short of the school career record.

Also nominated was freshman forward **Dustin King** of Grove City and freshman forward **Mike Chiodo** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

Senior **Stuart Bracher** scored both goals in Bethany's only game of the week, a 2-1 overtime win over Penn State-Behrend, giving him 64 for his career ... With three more goals, he will break the all-time Bethany goals record, held by **Star Sanyang** (1994-97) ... He also has 153 career points, 21 behind Sanyang for the all-time lead in that category ... In his first collegiate start, goal-keeper **Adam Seifert** made three saves in the Behrend triumph, subbing for an injured **Ryann Bradley**.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J split a pair of contests this past week, edging Waynesburg, 1-0, on Wednesday, before dropping a 5-0 decision at Westminster on Saturday ... The Presidents are 4-1 at home this season, including a 2-0 PAC record at Cameron Stadium ... Eight different Presidents have tallied goals this season ... Freshman forward **Mike Chiodo** scored the game's lone goal with just under 33 minutes to play in W&J's 1-0 victory over Waynesburg on Wednesday ... Chiodo eads the PAC in goals (8) and scoring (18 points).

Grove City Wolverines

After having a four-game winning streak stopped by Westminster 2-0 on Thursday, the Wolverines recorded their sixth shutout of the season with a 4-0 victory at Thiel on Saturday ... **Dustin King** scored two goals and **Chris Crefeld** added a goal and an assist in the win ... Grove City, now 7-2 overall, plays three games this week.

Waynesburg dropped its only game of the week to PAC rival Washington & Jefferson 1-0 on Wednesday.

Thiel went 1-1 last week, topping Lake Erie 4-0 in a non-conference match before dropping a 4-0 PAC decision against Grove City.
