PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

DAVID DIMARCO - Washington & Jefferson College

Junior forward - Pittsburgh, Pa./Sewickley Academy H.S.

Dimarco earned PAC Player of the Week laurels after helping W&J extend its winning streak to four games with victories over PAC rival Waynesburg (1-0) and Denison (3-0). He scored the game's only goal (his second straight game-winning goal) against the Yellow Jackets and added an assist on the game-winning goal against Denison.

Also nominated was senior forward Stuart Bracher of Bethany.

Bethany Bison

Bethany had its five-game winning streak snapped with its overtime loss at Frostburg on Saturday ... Senior **Stuart Bracher**'s tie-breaking goal against Westminster was the 67th of this career, breaking the all-time goals scored record at Bethany that was held by **Star Sanyang** ... He would score another goal to ice the Westminster win and scored the game-tying goal at Frostburg with just 37 seconds remaining in regulation ... Midfielder **Dan Irwin** recorded a hat trick against Westminster and added a goal and an assist in the Frostburg loss.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J continued its four-game winning streak this past week with road victories over Waynesburg and Denison ... The Presidents have racked up four consecutive shutouts and have not allowed a goal in over 360 minutes ... The last goal scored against W&J was in the final seconds of a 5-0 loss at Westminster on Sept. 29th ... Junior forward David Dimarco scored his second-straight game-winning goal in a 1-0 game against Waynesburg on Monday ... Junior forward Tom Cameron scored two second-half goals to lead W&J to the 3-0 shutout of Denison on Thursday ... Freshman forward Mike Chiodo notched his PAC-high 10th goal of the season in the first half against Denison ... Chiodo has now notched four game-winning goals this season.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines lost back-to-back games for the first time this season, falling at Westminster, 2-1, on Friday ... They lost at Bethany the previous Saturday, 2-1 ... Five former All-Americans and two former head coaches were installed as the College's first soccer hall of fame class on Saturday - the inductees include former Wolverine standouts Frank A. Sbrocco (1953-1957), Peter H. Büttner (1957-61), John J. Mulholland (1961-1965), Matthew R. Lux (1966-1970) and William G. Juergens (1983-1987), as well as legendary coaches Robert E. Thorn (1938-1956), and Clifford N. Wettia (1962-1970).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped a PAC contest to Washington & Jefferson (1-0) before topping Pitt-Greensburg (1-0) last week.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped contests to Baldwin-Wallace (5-1) and Case Western Reserve (3-0) last week, extending the Tomcat losing streak to five games.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's soccer team split a pair of games against PAC teams this week, falling to Bethany 5-3 on Wednesday before topping Grove City 2-1 on Saturday ... In the Bethany loss, junior midfielder **Tony Arrigo** posted a pair of goals, with junior forward **Carl Baldwin** also scoring ... Against GCC, Westminster scored twice in the last 10 minutes while a man down (due to a red card) to overcome a 1-0 deficit ... Arrigo scored the tying goal in the 80th minute, while freshman **John Booth** tallied the gamewinner in the 87th minute.
