Joe Testa chipped in with 11 points and Tyler Morando drained three three-pointers as well.

Geneva College split a pair of road games this golden TORNADOES past week including a

thrilling overtime victory at Waynesburg Univeristy on Wednesday ... The Golden Tornadoes rallied from 12 points down in the second half to win for the third straight time away from home ... Richard Colick scored 18 points and pulled down a career high 16 rebounds in the victory ... Geneva featured six players in double figures including 15 points each from Justin and Emilo Nardi ...
