Freshman Forward - Stowe, Pa./Pottsgrove H.S.

Sassaman led Waynesburg to a 1-0-1 week against PAC competition, as the Yellow Jackets defeated Waynesburg 3-1 before posting a double-overtime tie with Thiel 1-1. She recorded a pair of goals in the win over Bethany, including the game-winner.

Bethany split a pair of PAC contests last week, falling to Bethany 3-1 before posting a 2-0 shutout of Washington & Jefferson ... In recording her second shutout of the year, goalkeeper **Leondra Thomas** stopped 12 shots in the W&J win ... Midfielder **Missy Gibson** had a goal and an assist in the W&J win, while forward **Megan Maloney** assisted on the Bison's only goal against Waynesburg and scored the game-winner against W&J.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J women's soccer team remained winless at 0-6 after dropping PAC contests to Grove City (5-1) and Bethany (2-1) ... W&J's three-game scoring drought ended against Grove City with a goal by junior **Melissa Stanton** ... The Presidents outshot Bethany by a 15-14 count on Friday, marking the first time this season it has outshot an opponent ... Freshman goalkeeper **Gretchen Weber** has played 503 minutes for W&J and has racked up 78 saves.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City recovered from back-to-back overtime losses with a 5-1 victory over W&J in its PAC opener ... Kathy Keehlwetter scored twice in the win, while Diane Metzger, Meg Tilley and Autumn Hubbard added a goal each ... Tilley netted her team-high sixth goal of the season in a 4-1 loss at Westminster.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is unbeaten in its last seven games (6-0-1) after posting a 3-1 PAC win over Bethany and tying Thiel 1-1 in double overtime ... Freshman **Jackie Sassaman** scored two goals, including the game-winner, against Bethany.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a 4-1 decision at Case Western Reserve on Wednesday, before rebounding to tie Waynesburg 1-1 in double overtime on Saturday ... Thiel posted a 3-1 win on corner kicks after the Waynesburg game ... Laura Simonetti scored Thiel's lone goal against Waynesburg to tie the game and force it into overtime ... Simonetti is tied for the team lead in goals (five) and is first on the team in points (14) and assists (four).

Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's soccer team split two games to improve to 5-2 on the season this week, as the Lady Titans fell 2-1 at Wooster on Wednesday before topping Grove City 4-1 at home on Friday ... Wooster is ranked #9 in the NCAA D-III Region poll ... Senior forward Ashley Pyle posted the team's only goal in the loss at Wooster, then recorded a first half hat trick in the win over Grove City ... Junior midfielder Ashley Tonks scored the team's other goal against GCC, while also assisting on one of Pyle's first half goals.
