Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents are still looking to get Head Coach **Emily Houghton** her first victory of the season this week with games at Waynesburg, Pitt-Greensburg and Grove City ... The Presidents were shutout in all three games last week against Westminster (3-0), Frostburg State (3-0) and Thiel (4-0) ... Freshman goalkeeper **Gretchen Weber** recorded 44 saves in three contests last week ... Weber leads the PAC in saves (122) and saves per game (13.6).

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines picked up two more league victories to improve to 3-0-0 in the conference ... Grove City has outscored its first three league opponents, 10-1 ... The Lady Wolverines are 3-1-1 in their last five games after opening the year 1-4-1 ... Five different players accounted for the team's five goals last week ... Meg Tilley netted her team-high sixth of the year, Michelle Novosel buried her fifth of the fall ... Lindsey Cuffe tallied a goal and an assist in the team's 2-0-1 week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped a pair of contest last week, falling to Grove City 3-0 in a PAC contest before losing to Westminster 4-0 ... The Yellow Jackets played 3/4 of the Westminster game with only 10 players.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel has recorded three shutouts in 2001, the most ever in a single season for the Lady Cats ... Freshman **Laura Simonetti** has also became the all-time single season high point scorer with 20 points (8 goals and 4 assists) ... Sweeper **Katie Mound** was a major factor in helping the Lady Cats to a 2-0 week ... Besides helping the Thiel defense shut down the oppsosing offenses, Katie also helped out on the offensive side of the field, recording two goals and one assist against W&J on Sept. 29.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's soccer team posted road shutouts of PAC opponents Washington & Jefferson (3-0) and Waynesburg (4-0) this week ... The Lady Titans outshot W&J 32-1 and Waynesburg 26-1 ... Sophomore forward Alyssa Pyle scored all three goals against the Presidents, with one assisted by her older sister, senior forward Ashley Pyle ... Ashley Pyle and junior midfielder Ashley Tonks had two goals apiece against the Yellow Jackets, with junior forward Tammy Newell posting three assists ... Senior goalkeeper Sarah Morrison now has three shutouts on the season, giving her 19 in her collegiate career.
