Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's tennis team opened play against PAC competition this week, falling at Bethnay 6-3 on Tuesday before rebounding with an 8-1 home win over Washington & Jefferson on Thursday ... Westminster was paced in the Bethany loss by sophomore Carra Dixon, who posted victories at #5 singles and with junior Molly Householder at #3 doubles. ... Also victorious was freshman Amy Caliquiri, who earned her first collegiate singles win at #6 singles ...
