Grove City remained unbeaten in PAC play with a 9-0 sweep of W&J, before dropping a 5-4 non-conference match to Indiana (Pa.) ... Four Lady Wolverines — Alyssa Bradford, Lisa Oriti, Allison Atwood, and Erika Hauge — competed at the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) Southeast Regional last weekend at Mary Washington College in Fredericksburg, VA ... Bradford advanced the farthest in the 64-player singles tournament, winning three matches before losing to the defending ITA regional champion in the quarterfinals.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg completed a busy week with a win at Hiram on Saturday ... The Jackets played four matches for the second week in a row ... They started the week by defeating Pitt-Greensburg at home before traveling to Westminster on Wednesday ...
