Gomes was 3-0 in singles action last week, losing only six games in six sets as Bethany went 3-0 with wins over Waynesburg (8-1), Hiram (6-3) and Westminster (5-4). She is now 9-2 in singles play and has not lost a set in any of her nine wins.
