She followed up that performance with a a game high 22 points and nine rebounds in the Saints' win over Geneva.

SAINTS CLINCH TOP SPOT: Thomas More clinched the No.1 seed in the upcoming PAC Tournament with a home victory against W&J on Wednesday ... Despite the loss W&J secured the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament and will host a quarterfinal game in the Henry Memorial Center ... Bethany's 2-0 week clinched a home game in the quarterfinal round of the PAC Tournament as well ... The winner of the matchup between Grove City and Thiel on Saturday will earn the No 4. seed.

WHO'S HOT: Thomas More is ranked 11th (D3Hoops.com) and 12th (WBCA) in the two national D-III Top 25 polls, while W&J is 18th in D3Hoops.com and is the top team also receiving votes in the WBCA ... W&J junior F **Maggie Gibson** grabbed her 800th career rebound ... Sophomore F **Christine Slater** averaged 16.5 points and 10.0 rebounds per game for 1-1 Grove City ... Senior F **Kristen Humphrey** bucketed 13 points against W&J and added 21 against Geneva for 2-0 Thomas More.

A 15-2 run midway through the 2nd half allowed BC to pull away from Grove City, who were forced into 27 turnovers that were converted in 32 Bison points ... **Kaitlyn McCormick** scored all 13 of her markers in the 2nd half and **Renee Sheperd** and **Stacy Goode** each had 11 ... BC won a sloppy contest at Chatham, as the teams combined for 50 turnovers .. **Caelyn Disanti** fired in 12 points and had 5 rebounds, while **Renee Brandenburg** totaled 8 points and 7 boards to help BC finish with a 55-32 rebounding advantage.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-14)

The Golden Tornadoes dropped a 65-58 decision at Waynesburg before falling 84-64 to 13th ranked Thomas More ... **Michawn Rich** had 23 points in the loss at Waynesburg while teammates **Christine Carugati** and **Beth DeLuca** shared a team high 12 points down in Kentucky ... Geneva will put its 8-14 record on the line this week with two PAC match-ups to close out the 2008-09 season.

Grove City Wolverines (10-13, 6-7 PAC)



Grove City stayed alive for a potential home game in the PAC Tournamen by earning a 62-41 win at Waynesburg Saturday night ... Four Grove City players scored in double figures ... **Megan Gebrosky** and **Christine Slater** both pumped in 16 points while **Krista Beechy** and **Raeann Szelong** each had a dozen points ... Grove City held Waynesburg to five second-half field goals ... The Wolverines committed just three turnovers in the final 20 minutes ... Wednesday night, Bethany handed Grove City a 67-59 setback ... Slater recorded a 17-point, 14-rebound double-double while **Laura Miller** also fired in 17 points ... Beechy added 10 ... Bethany has now won four straight at Grove City.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-7)



The Bearcats split a pair of home contests on the week, defeating Thiel 73-64 on Wednesday before falling 75-68 to W&J on Saturday ... **Ashley Campbell** had a big game in the Thiel win, scoring 20 points to go with six assists and six steals ... **Maria Baroffio** added 15 points and **Emily Fenton** 13, each connecting on three three-pointers ... The game was tied with 13 minutes left in the second half before SVC out-scored the Tomcats 41-30 to end the game ... In Saturday's loss to W&J, Baroffio scored 25 points and Fenton 16, hitting four treys ... Campbell added nine points to go with seven assists and four steals.

Thiel Tomcats (9-11, 4-8 PAC)



After a disappointing 64-73 loss to the Bearcats at Saint Vincent, Thiel snapped their five-game losing streak by dismantling the Westminster Titans 83-60 ... **Amber Bodrick** finished the game against the Titants with a season- and game-high 32 points, to go along with 10 rebounds, four assists, two steals and two blocked shots ... Freshman forward, **Ashley Davis**, did her best Ray Allen impersonation dropping 16 points on 6-of-7 shooting, while freshman duo, **Towanda-Michelle Warren** and **Rianne Thornton**, held things down on the defensive end, finishing the game with four and five steals respectively.

Thomas More Saints (21-2, 12-1 PAC)



Thomas More swept its two games last week as it defeated No. 18 W&J, 56-45, on Wednesday and Geneva, 84-64, on Saturday to extend its winning streak to a season high 10 games ... The win over W&J clinched the Saints the No.1 seed in the upcoming PAC Tournament and their fourth straight 20 win season ... Against W&J the Saints were led in scoring by senior F **Kristen Humphrey** with 13 points and senior G **Jayne Thiem** with 12 points and nine rebounds ... Then against Geneva, Thiem scored a game-high 22 points and pulled down nine rebounds, while Humphrey added a career-high tying 21 points and sophomore **Nicole Dickman** finished with a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

The 18th-ranked W&J College women's basketball program fell a game and a half behind Thomas More in the PAC standings after dropping an 11-point decision against the Saints on Wednesday in Kentucky ... Prior to Wednesday's loss against TMC, the Presidents were ranked third in the first Great Lakes Region poll of the 2008-09 season ... The Presidents trailed DePauw (19-3) and Hope (18-1), while the Saints (21-2) held down the fourth position ... The Presidents have secured the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament and will host a quarterfinal game ... Junior F **Maggie Gibson** reached a milestone mark in her career on Saturday as she grabbed her 800th career rebound.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-15, 4-8 PAC)



The Waynesburg women went 1-1 this past week with a 65-58 win over Geneva on Wednesday, Feb.11, and a 62-41 loss to Grove City on Saturday, Feb.14 ... White racked up a game-best 24 points, while Jones added 18 to the winning effort ... Freshman point gaurd **Hannah Hunter** racked up the most assists by a Waynesburg player in a single game since 2006 with 10 helpers ... Unfortunately, things didn't go as well against the Wolverines as the Jackets saw a three-point halftime lead evaporate.

Westminster snapped a seven-game losing streak by beating Chatham 54-50, on Wednesday night ... The Titans then absored an 86-60 loss at Thiel on Saturday afternoon ...
