Bethany Bison

Bethany placed second in men's competition and had an incomplete women's team score at the Washington & Jefferson Invitational ... **Tiffany Baumgart** and **Kristy McGrew** finshed eighth and 10th respectively at the W&J meet to lead the Bison women ... **Nick Jordan** was the Bison highest finisher for the men, crossing in 20th place.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J hosted the W&J Invitational this past weekend and the men's squad finished third of four teams, while the women's squad placed fourth of four teams... Senior **Joe Henderson** posted the men's squad top time with a 10th place finish in a time of 30.44 ... Senior **Dave Rometo** also placed 23rd (33.03) ... The women's squad was led by junior **Kim Nowak**'s fifth-place finish in a time of 22.43 ... Junior **Michelle Mantine** placed 7th in a time of 22:56.

Grove City Wolverines

In its first of two trips to the Lehigh Valley this fall, the Grove City College men's cross country team placed eighth among 17 Division III schools at the 28th Lehigh University Paul Short Run, which annually attracts the best teams in the region ... In all, 62 schools from all three NCAA divisions were represented ... Junior Ryan Mitchell was the first Wolverine to cross the finish line, placing 18th among Division III runners in 27:07.49 ... The Lady Wolverine cross country team placed sixth among 19 of the top Division III schools in the region ... Freshman Jana Sallade paced the Lady Wolverines on the 6K course with a time of 23:53.46, good for 23rd in the D-III field.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg women's cross country team finished second in the W&J Cross Country Invitational, the team's highest finish in an event this season ... Provisional conference member Westminster captured top team honors in the event ... Sophomore **Sara Linger** led the Jackets runners to a second place finish in the W&J Invitational. She finished 9th overall (23.20) to place first among Jacket runners.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men and women placed third and fourth, respectively, at the W&J Invitational on Saturday ... Freshman Matt Rowlands led the men by placing fourth in 29:28, while frosh Mary Beth Scialabba led the Lady Cats by finishing second in 21:26.

Westminster Titans

Westminster swept the men's and women's team titles at the Washington & Jefferson Invitational in Washington, Pa., this weekend ... Senior Jacob Gleason captured the men's race, giving him three invitational crowns in the past four weeks ... Gleason posted a course-record time of 27:54, breaking the old mark of 28:25 set by Tim Sabella of Grove City ... Lady Titan senior Desiree Henry won her fifth race in six starts this season, posting a course-record time of 20:34 to break the old mark of 20:50 held by Truly Norman of Geneva.
