5-11 Sophomore Outfielder

Bell hit .600 (6-for-10) as the defending PAC champion Tomcats opened their season by splitting a pair of games at the Gene Cusic Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. Bell was 3-for-5 with two doubles and two steals in a 10-8 win over New Jersey City, then went 3-for-5 again in a 12-5 loss to Muskingum.

Also nominated was senior P/1B **Todd Welsh** of Bethany, senior OF/P **Greg Grupp** of Grove City, and freshman OF **Justin Marsiniko** of Waynesburg.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison started the 2004 season with an 8-7 win over Division II St. Thomas Aquinas in Fort Pierce, Fla. ... Senior **Todd Welsh** got the win, striking out eight batters in six innings and allowing just one earned run in the victory ... **Ian Edwards** earned the save, striking out one batter in the seventh ... Sophomore transfer **Dan Berty** had two singles and two RBI in his Bison debut at shortstop, while senior **Matt Raiti** drove in four runs ... The Bison lost their next two games, to Northland (Wisc.) 13-2, and Simpson (Iowa) 15-2 ... In the first game, **Rich Majewski** collected a single and a double ... The Bison had five errors in the loss ... In the second game, the Bison left the bases loaded twice.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson opens its 2004 schedule on Tuesday, March 16th, as it hosts Mount Union in a doubleheader at 1:00 pm ... W&J will also host Pitt-Bradford the next day in a nine-inning affair ... Second-year Head Coach **Jeff Mountain** has one of the youngest rosters in all of Division III with one junior, six sophomores and 25 freshmen.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened the season by competing in the Gene Cusic Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. Feb. 26-28 ... CF **Jerry Ott** hit .444 (8-for-18) during the week while DH/P **Greg Grupp** drove in seven runs and cracked four doubles ... **Ryan Carr** and **Chris Hull** each picked up victories on the mound, while relievers **Eric Arnesen** and **Luke Lester** had saves ... Head coach **Rob Skaricich** earned his 100th career win against Seton Hill ... Sixteen different position players started at least one game on the trip, with 10 making multiple starts ... Grove City opens conference play March 26 against Westminster ... One day later, Grove City begins the home portion of the schedule, also against Westminster.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened its season Feb. 21 by dropping a doubleheader at Hampden-Sydney, 4-2 and 12-2 ... In the first game, Waynesburg out-hit the Tigers, 7-6, but two sixth-inning runs off reliever **Dan Coghlan** was the difference ... Starting P **Eric Holt** hurled four innings of four-hit ball, giving up one run ... Holt scored Waynesburg's second run in the third inning after reaching on a fielder's choice and scoring on a **Brian Gerginski** single ... In the second game, Waynesburg fell behind 11-0 when the Tigers posted seven runs in the third inning ... **Justin Schrader** suffered the loss giving up four hits and four runs (one earned) ... Freshman LF **Justin Marsinko** led the Jackets' two-run, seven-hit attack accounting for three hits and two RBI.

Thiel Tomcats

The defending PAC champion Tomcats opened their season in Florida at the Gene Cusic Collegiate Classic on Saturday, defeating New Jersey City 10-8 in the opener before falling to Muskingum 12-5 on Sunday ... Senior **Jarred Floch** picked up the win against NJC, going seven innings with four strikeouts while allowing a pair of earned runs ... Senior **Bryan Goble** got the save, working 1.2 innings and allowing just one hit and an unearned run ... Sophomore 3B **Bob Flukas** paced the Thiel offense going 2-for-5 with a pair of doubles and three RBI ... Sophomore OF **Brett Bell** was 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles and two stolen bases ... Senior OF **Jon Keenan** was 2-for-5 with two RBI.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opens the 2004 season at NAIA member St. Vincent with a non-conference doubleheader this Thursday, March 11 at 1 p.m. ... The Titans are scheduled to play nine varsity games in seven days in Homestead, Fla., from March 13-19 ...
