STEVE MAHLER

Waynesburg College 5-11 Junior Third Baseman Pittsburgh, Pa./Central Catholic H.S.

Mahler was named PAC Player of the Week after going 9-for-23 (.391) with one double, one triple, four runs scored and six RBIs for Waynesburg in eight games last week. He hit a bases-clearing, two-out triple in the Jackets 7-3 win over Ursinus and posted the game-winning hit in the bottom of the seventh of the team's 2-1 win over Penn State-Altoona. He also scored the game-winning run in the Jackets 3-2 win over Widener.

Also nominated was junior first baseman Randy Chiquelin of Thiel.
