Bethany Bison

The Bison opened their season by going 2-5 during their spring break trip to Ft. Pierce, Fla. ... In their second game of the trip, BC scored 10 runs in the top of the 9th inning, then escaped a bases loaded, one-out situation in the bottom of the frame in a wild 13-12 win over La Roche ... LF **Milton Joyner** was 4-for-6 with three RBIs and **Mike Klamerus** drove in three runs as well ... BC's second win of the Florida swing was a 13-1 rout over Marywood, as **Aaron Brest** allowed one unearned run on four hits in 6 2/3 innings and DH **Brent Owens** knocked in five runs ... Joyner led the team with a .406 batting average (13-for-32), while scoring six runs and driving in six ... Owens (.280) and 3B **Chris Jeffers** (.267) tied for the team lead with eight RBIs.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened the season by winning four of five games in Port Charlotte, Fla. ... For the second straight season, Grove City knocked off a nationally-ranked foe in Florida as the Wolverines split a doubleheader with No. 16 Augustana ... **Chris Bowser** earned the win, allowing just one run and two hits in four innings ... Against St. John's Friday, sophomore LHP **Zach Hillegas** and freshman **Michael Herringshaw** each picked up victories while senior closer **Justin Miller** saved both ends of the doubleheader ... Miller then earned his first win of 2007 March 3 as Grove City trimmed Concordia-Moorhead (Minn.) in 10 innings, 11-9 ... Junior 2B **Bryan Pierrot** doubled in two runs in the top of the 10th ... Junior CF **Brian Moran** hit .471 (8-of-17) for the week.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel completed its most successful spring trip in school history last week, returning to Greenville with a 6-2 record at the Gene Cusic Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. ... Sophomore SS **Chad Ulogar** paced Thiel offensively, hitting .448 with 10 runs and five RBI's ... Ulogar also added a pair of saves off of the mound ... Freshman RHP **Dave Graff** finished 2-0 with a 2.99 ERA, while sophomore LHP **Josh Tedesco** added a pair of victories via the bullpen ... Sophomore C **Andrew Howard** started six games behind the plate and hit .450.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More started its season with two road wins after having its home opener postponed due to weather ... The Saints scored twice in the top of the ninth inning to beat Transylvania 5-3, as freshman **Matt Klausing** earned his first collegiate win with four innings of relief ... Junior **Pat Berndsen** started the game, allowing two runs on four hits over four innings ... Senior **Fred Riess** drove in three runs as Thomas More defeated Hanover 8-3 ... Starter **Kyle Wewe** yielding an unearned run in the first, then held the Panthers to just one hit over the next three innings ... TMC pitching allowed just three earned runs in the two games ... The duo of **Marc Price** and **Dustin Brown** combined to score eight of the Saints' 13 runs and went 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson was scheduled to open its 2007 schedule on Tuesday, but the game with Frostburg State has been rescheduled for April 26th in Washington, Pa. ... The Presidents will now start the season on Saturday vs. Ramapo in Port Charlotte, Fla.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets posted a 5-3 mark in their second-straight trip to Disney's Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, Fla. ... After dropping a doubleheader sweep to Salve Regina (R.I.), Waynesburg won four straight games, including sweeping doubleheaders with Martin Luther (Minn.) and Muhlenberg ... The Yellow Jackets lost the first half of a doubleheader with Wisconsin Lutheran before claiming a split with a 7-2 victory in the final game of the week ... Waynesburg is idle until Wednesday, March 21, when it travels to face defending national-champion Marietta.



Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a record of 6-4 in 10 games held in Fort Pierce, Fla. ... Sophomore SS **Nick Maiorano** led the Titans with batting .462 (12-for-26), while sophomore 3B **Mike Busin** (.438) and junior OF **Donnie Womeldorff** (.412) each led the team with 14 hits and 8 RBIs ... The top pitcher was junior **Andrew Robison** who went 2-0 in two starts ... Robison compiled a 2.70 ERA giving up four earned runs and 15 hits in 13.1 innings ... Other notable performances included sophomore **Adam Blythe** with two home runs vs. Marywood and junior **Thomas Fee** and senior **Dan Conti** with walk-off game-winning RBI hits ... Fee hit a one-run double to beat Marywood, 6-5, while Conti slapped a two-out, two-run single with the bases loaded to beat Eastern, 10-9.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats opened the 2007 season by going 3-5 at the Gene Cusic Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. ... Newcomer **Dave Jones**, a sophomore, is leading the team with a .478 average, including a game-winning triple in the season opener against Muskingum ... He posted four steals as well during the week ... Senior **Mike Shock** hit .407 for the week and also stole four bases ... Senior **Dave Russell** hit three home runs for the week and is batting .346 ... Sophomore **Rob Patula** is 2-0 and has not given up a run ... He picked up the win in relief in the season opener, then threw a four-hit shutout over Hiram later in the week ... Freshman **Frank Furfari** has 11 strikeouts in 7.2 innings.
