#### PAC BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### RANDY CHIQUELIN

Thiel College

6-4 Senior First Baseman/Designated Hitter Knoxville, Tenn./Hamburg (N.Y.) H.S.

Chiquelin is batting .591 (13-of-22) with one double, three home runs and 17 RBIs for the Tomcats through 12 games. He went 4-for-7 in a DH sweep of Pitt-Greensburg Sunday, going 3-for-3 in the nightcap with a grand slam.

Also nominated was freshman DH **Matt Mark** of Washington & Jefferson, senior C **Bill Tenney** of Waynesburg, and junior P **Pat Boyle** of Westminster.

## PAC BASEBALL NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany opened the 2003 season with a 6-2 loss at Roanoke Friday night ... After falling behind 2-0 in the first, the Bison got on the board in the third frame when a single by RF Matt Raiti chased home CF Scott Johnson ... 1B D.J. Hynes clubbed a solo homer in the seventh to bring Bethany back to a 3-2 score but the Maroons put the game away with three runs in the bottom of the seventh ... Bethany's nine-hit attack was led by Hynes, who had a homer and a double, while SS Rich Majewski had a single, stolen base and two walks ... The Bison rebounded the next day to claim a 2-1 victory at Maryville in the first game of a twinbill before dropping an 8-7 decision in the nightcap.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened its 2003 season yesterday evening as Fontbonne (Mo.) swept a doubleheader from the Presidents ... Fontbonne doubled up W&J, 12-2, in game one in six innings and then took a 12-9 decision in game two ... The Presidents were hurt by errors in game one as six miscues allowed seven unearned runs ... Freshman hurler Tim Miller took the loss after throwing 4 2/3 innings, allowing 11 runs (four earned) on seven hits, while striking out three ... Freshman DH Matt Mark went 2-for-2 with two RBI, while senior CF B.J. Swartzlander added a double ... In game two, W&J held a 6-2 lead after four innings, but a ninerun fifth frame helped Fontbonne earn the sweep ... Junior 1B Rob Roth went 2for-2 with two RBI and two runs scored.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

The two-time defending PAC champion Wolverines prepare for Tuesday's opener against CWRU ... The Wolverines' trip to southern Virginia never materialized as poor weather canceled the trip earlier this month ... Grove City has just two seniors, first baseman **Steve Navarro** and catcher **Matt Skipper** ... The Wolverines open PAC play March 28 at home against Bethany.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After returning from the Cocoa Expo in Cocoa Beach, Fla., Waynesburg had two games postponed on Wednesday and Friday, before losing at St. Vincent, 5-2, on Saturday ... The loss to the Bearcats marked junior P Dan Coghlan's first loss of the season after going 2-0 at Florida ... Bill Tenney supplied Waynesburg's lone offense going 2-for-4 with a two-run single in the third inning ... Tenney is Waynesburg's leading batter with .516 batting average, 16 hits, and 13 RBI ... He hit recorded multiple hits in five of the team's nine games ... Junior P Eric Holt pitched a gem to increase Waynesburg's season-high three-game win streak on March 7, by serving up a one-hitter in the Jackets 6-0 win over Widener ... Senior 3B Steve Mahler was 4-for-4 in the win.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats spent their Spring Break in Ft. Myers, Fla. at the Gene Cusic Classic ... Thiel went 2-8 on their spring trip, posting wins over Ohio Northern (8-6) and Olivet (14-11) ... Senior 1B/3B Randy Chiquelin batted .600 on the trip with two HR and 11 RBI ... Freshman C Kinsey Henderson hit three doubles and left Florida with a .367 average ... Freshman RF Brett Bell hit .314 with six stolen bases ... Freshmen 3B Bob Flukas finished the trip with a .273 average, three HR and four RBI ... Thiel swept a doubleheader from Pitt-Greensburg on Saturday, taking the first game 7-2 and the second contest 17-9 ... Senior 1B Jim Chester led the Tomcats in the opener, going 2for-3 with a solo HR and three RBI.

#### Westminster Titans

The Titans opened 2003 on a positive note, going 5-2 on a Spring Break trip in Fort Pierce, Fla. ... Junior Pat Boyle earned a pair of victories on the mound, while senior Matt Pournaras, junior Craig Rechichar and freshman Brenton Gilmore also earned pitching wins ... Top hitters included junior IFs Justin Joseph (.538 average) and Brian Goettler (.475 average, 1 double, 8 runs scored) and senior SS B.G. Davison (.381 average, 3 RBIs, 4 steals) ... Pitching was the highlight of the trip for the Titans, as Westminster posted a team ERA of 1.12 in seven games (six earned runs in 48 innings with 44 strikeouts) ... Pournaras' win came in a 10-2 victory over NCAA Division II opponent Northwood (Mich.).
