Bethany Bison

Bethany fell in three games to Penn State Behrend during a weekend series at Bethany Park ... BC led 2-1 going into the seventh of game one Saturday and was one out away from a win when Behrend got a walk and a pinch-hit

home run ... The Lions added an insurance run, which was needed because Bison LF **Aaron Meadows** clubbed a solo homer in the bottom of the frame ... Game 2 saw Bethany rally from a 7-3 deficit to send the game to extra innings, but Behrend prevailed behind two runs in the ninth ... In Sunday's finale, BC led 1-0 after four, but the Lions scored two in the seventh and three in the eighth to come way with a 6-2 win ... CF **Rich Majewski** went 6-12 over the weekend with a homer, two RBI and three runs scored.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished the week 3-1, splitting a double-header at Muskingum (6-3, 3-5) Saturday and sweeping a doubleheader at home against Pitt-Greensburg (13-2, 7-6) Sunday ... In game one Saturday, freshman 1B Eric Boylan went 2-for-3 while sophomore P Eric Wadowsky picked

up the complete-game win, allowing five hits and three runs (two earned) with four strikeouts ... Senior DH/1B **Mark Nightingale** drove in a total of six runs for the Tomcats in their doubleheader sweep of UP-G ... Nightingale finished 4-for-4 with four runs, four RBIs and a two-run home run in game one and added a pair of RBIs in game two ... Senior P **Rich McNea**l improved to 2-0 with the game one win, allowing seven hits and two runs (1 earned) with five strikeouts.

Grove City opened the northern part of its 2006 schedule Saturday by sweeping a double-header from host Pitt-Greensburg, 5-1 and 9-2... In the opener, senior **Erik Arnesen** fanned 13 in a complete game effort to give him 21

strikeouts in 14 innings this year ... Grove City's keystone combination of 2B **Ben Wilson** and SS **Mike Ritter** each homered, while CF **Chris Schwamberger** doubled, singled and drove in two runs ... DH Mike Hess also doubled ... Schwamberger and 3B **Bryan Pierrot** each drove in three runs in the nightcap ... Pierrot went 2-for-4 while C **Ray Mertz** went 2-for-2 with a sacrifice ... **Ryan Carr** earned the win, striking out six in six innings ... DH **Pat Messner** cracked a double in the game two win.



Thomas More Saints

Behind stellar pitching, Thomas More went 4-0 last week ... The Saints haven't allowed an earned run in 26

straight innings and had a streak of scoreless innings snapped at 22 ... **Brett Walter** and **Anthony Reiber** each tallied complete game shutouts, while **Pat Berndsen** didn't allow an earned run in his complete game effort ...
