Handley led the 25th-ranked Saints to a per-

fect 4-0 week last week, as he batted .667 (10-for-15) with three doubles, six runs scored and 12 RBIs and a pair of stolen bases for Thomas More in wins over Centre (13-7), Hanover (13-5) and a DH sweep of Bluffton (17-3, 6-4).

Zivoder was the hard-luck loser for W&J in a 1-0 complete game loss to Loras in Florida, giving up just one unearned run while striking out a career-best 10 batters in eight innings of work.


Geneva Golden Tornadoes (10-3)
