# **ERIC HOLT**

Waynesburg College 6-3 Junior Pitcher/Outfielder Washington, Pa./Trinity H.S.

Holt led Waynesburg to a 4-2 week, including DH sweeps of La Roche and Pitt-Greensburg. He hit .300 (6-of-20) with two home runs and six RBIs for the week, while also pitching a four-hit shutout with six strikeouts in a 1-0 win over La Roche. His third inning RBI single proved to be the game's only run.

Also nominated was sophomore C/3B Paul Krisanda of Bethany, freshman CF Jason DeMeo of Grove City, junior SS Caleb Goist of Thiel, senior CF B.J. Swartzlander of Washington & Jefferson, and senior P/1B Matt Pournaras of Westminster.

# **Bethany Bison**

Bethany finished its southern trip with a 3-7 record ... The Bison recorded wins over Grinnell (11-5) and Principia (10-1) ... The Grinnell victory was highlighted by eight different players knocking home runs, including three by 3B Billy Deer ... Todd Welsh tossed five innings and struck out eight to get the win ... In the Principia triumph, freshman P Adam Martin tossed a gem, allowing one run on five hits in going the distance for his first collegiate win ... Seven different Bison collected RBIs, including two each to C Justin Waychoff, 3B Paul Krisanda and Welsh ... Krisanda finished thre trip with seven extra-base hits, including three home runs.

# Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J concluded its spring break trip to Fort Myers, Fla., with a 2-5 record ... The Presidents defeated SUNY-Plattsburgh and New England on the trip, but fell to Fontbonne (twice), Messiah, Augsburg and Millikin ... In the nine-run rout of SUNY-Plattsburgh, freshman P Ross Kelchner tossed a complete game sixhitter in his first collegiate start, striking out five and walking one ... W&J had six players with at least two hits, led by senior RF Brent Rockwell who was 3-for-45 with three runs and two RBI ... Senior CF B.J. Swartzlander also was 3-for-5 with two RBI ... Swartzlander had three hits, three RBI and four runs scored vs. New England ... Freshman P Tim Miller earned his first collegiate win by limiting New England to three earned runs.

# **Grove City Wolverines**

The Wolverines finally opened the 2003 season with a split at Case Western Reserve on Thursday ... Freshman CF jason DeMeo and junior RF Greg Grupp noth doubled, singled and drove in three runs in the nightcap victory over Case while junior Sean O'Donnell got the win in relief of starter Matt Kearney ... Senior 1B Steve Navarro doubled and singled in the opener ... In a non-conference game at Westminster Saturday, the Wolverines jumped out to a 4-1 lead before the Titans won with a pair of unearned runs in the seventh ... DeMeo and Michael McMillen both doubled and singled ... GCC opens its home schedule against Pitt-Greensburg Wednesday before starting PAC play vs. Bethany on Friday.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened the week with backto-back doubleheader sweeps of La Roche and Pitt-Greensburg, before a 23-5 loss at Frostburg State and a 7-6 loss at Pitt-Bradford over the weekend ... Senior C Bill Tenney and junior P/OF Eric Holt starred in the wins ... Tenney's fourhit, three-RBI performance in a 10-0 win over UPG included two doubles and a homer, while Holt cranked a home run in the 7-0 win in the opener ... Holt wasalso the catalyst in the sweep of La Roche by pitching a complete-game shutout of the Redhawks, with six strikeouts, no walks and four hits ... His third inning single helped his own cause and proved to be the game-winner in a 1-0 game ... Holt's three-run home run in game one propelled Waynesburg to a 9-2 win.

# **Thiel Tomcats**

The Tomcats fell in their only contest last week, a 5-4 loss at Hiram on 3/19 ... Thiel (4-9) out hit the Terriers 13-11 in the game ... Hiram led 5-2 after seven innings, but the Tomcats scored a run in both the eighth and nine frames to close the gap to 5-4 before the failed comeback ... Sophomore 2B Jon Spencer was 1-for-4 on the afternoon with a two-run double, a run scored and a stolen base ... Junior SS Caleb Goist finished 3-for-5 with a double, a run and a stolen base, while senior 1B Jim Chester went 1-for-5 with an RBI and scored once ... Junior lefthander Jarred Floch fell to 2-2 on the season as he went eight innings, allowing 11 hits and five runs (four earned) while striking out a pair of batters.

# Westminster Titans

The Titans ran their win streak to four with three wins last week, sweeping La Roche (10-3 and 8-1) on Wednesday before topping Grove City 6-5 in a non-conference game on Saturday ...
