PAC BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

GEORGE TAYLOR

Waynesburg College 6-1 Junior Outfielder Washington, Pa./Chartiers-Houston H.S.

Taylor led Waynesburg to a 2-1 week and earned PAC Player of the Week laurels after hitting .714 (5-of-7) with three walks, five runs scored, one double, one home run, two RBIs and three steals in the three games. He also pitched one scoreless inning for the Jackets.

Also nominated freshman OF **Nelson Rodriguez** of Bethany, junior 1B **Randy Chiquelin** of Thiel, and freshman C/2B **Frank Pilato** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

After suffering their fourth shutout of the year against YSU, the Bison broke in the win column for the first time this year at PSU-Altoona ... Bethany took a 13-0 lead after three innings and picked up a 17-9 victory ... The Green and White pounded out 21 hits in the triumph, led by 3B Max Schimmel's 5-6 and two doubles performance ... SS Sean Flood went 4-6 with a pair of RBI's and LF Nelson Rodriguez went 2-2 with three walks and five RBIs, which included a grand slam ... Schimmel, Rodriguez and C Paul Krisanda scored four runs each ... Todd Welsh picked up the win on the hill.

Washington & Jefferson concluded its spring trip to Fort Pierce, Fla., with a 1-6 record, defeating SUNY-New Paltz in its only win ... despite losing six of seven games, W&J still posted a .354 batting average in Florida ...
