WJU tacked on two more runs before the Bison closed the scoring with an RBI single from DH **Brent Owens** in the seventh inning, which was his team-leading 11th RBI of the year ... Freshman P **Kelson Jerrel** was solid in relief, throwing four innings and allowing just two runs on five hits while striking out five and walking none.

Thiel Tomcats

Thomas More opened PAC play by taking a three-game series from Thiel. The Saints took the first two games, 2-

0 and 3-0, respectively ... The consecutive shutouts ran TMC streak to 40 innings without allowing an unearned run ... It was also the sixth straight complete game by Thomas More starters ... Senior **Anthony Reiber** and freshman **Kyle Wewe** each have consecutive complete games, while Reiber threw his second straight shutout ... Senior **Brad Thoma** led the Saints with a .455 batting average, while freshman **Adam Helsley** and sophomore **Marc Price** each finished with .333 batting averages.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J wrapped up its spring trip with a 6-2 record in Port Charlotte, Fla., including a sweep of preseason No. 6 Wisconsin-Stevens Point ... The Presidents were led on their eight-game swing by sophomore CF **Justin Benson**, who batted .500 (15-for-30) with five extra-base hits and seven RBI ... Sophomore LF **Ryan Gregg** hit .400

(10-for-25) on the trip and reached base in 16-of-31 plate appearances ... Junior **John Astfalk** and freshman **Dan Vietmeier** both recorded a pair of victories on the mound ... Astfalk earned wins over St. Joseph's (4-3) and St. Olaf (8-4), while Vietmeier hurled the final three innings in the game one victory over Stevens Point and then threw seven shutout innings versus Ramapo ... Freshman P **Ian Poole** also posted one win and one save during the trip.

The Yellow Jackets opened PAC play with a 20-13 victory over Westminster Friday, before the Titans swept the Saturday doubleheader with two one-run games, 4-3 and 5-4 ... In the win Friday, all nine Yellow Jacket starters posted a hit and eight of the nine posted at least one RBI ... **Drew Denham** and **Phil Anderson** each collected four

hits, while Anderson and **Adam Bear** led the team with three RBI each ... In the first game Saturday, 2B **Brian Gerginski** extended his career-long hit streak to 15 games with an RBI single in the third ... However, the Titans plated the game-winner in the fourth and Gerginski's hit streak was snapped in game two ... In the sixth inning of the nightcap, Waynesburg plated two runs to make it a one-run contest, 5-4, but would get no closer ... Freshman P **Brad Griffith** took the loss despite allowing just two earned runs in six innings.

Sophomore P Andy Robison earned saves in both Saturday wins, with sophomore Jake Zatchok and freshman Gary DeBaldo earning the wins ... Senior 1B Brian Andrews hit a three-run home run in the opener, then broke a 2-2 tie with a two-run double in game two ... In

the Friday loss, freshman OF **John Izzo** was 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles, two runs scored and four RBIs ... The Titans overcame a 4-1 deficit to win at La Roche, with Izzo earning the win in relief.
