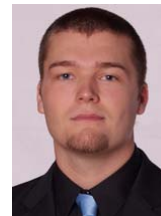


PAC Hitter of the Week

Ziants led the Bison to a 4-1 week (2-1 PAC) by batting .667 (10-for-15) with a pair of doubles, four runs scored and nine RBIs. He also drew five walks on the week for a .750 on base percentage, reaching base at least twice in all five contests. Ziants was a perfect 4-for-4 with five RBIs in a 12-5 Bison road PAC victory at Grove City.

Also nominated was junior 1B **Kyle Shock** of Grove City, senior C **Erik Fichter** of Saint Vincent, senior 1B **Weston Snyder** of Thiel, sophomore RF **Josh Staniscia** of Washington & Jefferson, senior C **Brendan Scioscia** of Waynesburg, and junior 2B **Kyle Allen** of Westminster.

Oviatt earned his second PAC weekly honor this season after posting a 2-0 record with a 1.93 ERA. After posting a complete-game victory with no walks and four strikeouts in a 5-3 win over Penn State-Behrend Monday, he posted a complete game four-hit (all singles) shutout with one walk and five strikeouts in a 12-0 blanking of defending PAC champion and #18-Thomas More Sunday. Oviatt is now 5-0 on the year for the Yellow Jackets, with complete games in all five starts.

Also nominated was freshman **Ryan Meier** of Bethany, sophomore **Caleb Kilgore** of Geneva, freshman **Blaine Lang** of Grove City, junior **Jared Haller** of Saint Vincent, sophomore **Eddie Nogay** of Washington & Jefferson, senior C **Brendan Scioscia** of Waynesburg, and senior **Justin Prejsnar** of Westminster.

OFF AND RUNNING: The first full weekend of PAC baseball action has concluded, with Westminster the lone team to post a series sweep as the Titans went 3-0 vs. Thiel ... After falling 15-7 in the series opener Saturday, Waynesburg outscored Thomas More by a combined 21-2 in a Sunday DH to take the series from the defending PAC champions.

NEWS & NOTES: Washington & Jefferson completed its Florida Spring Break trip with a perfect 7-0 mark, concluding with a 5-2 win over 6th-ranked Wisconsin-Stevens Point ... The 9-1 Presidents are off to their best start since beginning the 2007 season 10-1 ... Bethany freshman P **Ryan Meier** earned a win and a save while posting a 1.04 ERA in 8 2/3 innings.

AROUND THE PAC: Westminster junior 2B **Kyle Allen** hit .400 with a double and two RBIs ... Junior LHP **Jared Haller** fired his second straight complete game shutout for Saint Vincent in a 12-0 win vs. Geneva ... **Jon Bushmire** blasted a pair of solo home runs for Geneva in a 9-5 PAC win over SVC ... Thiel senior 1B **Weston Snyder** hit .500 (8-for-16).

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (5-6, 3-3 PAC)



Bethany snapped a five-game losing streak with a sweep of Pitt-Greensburg Tuesday and went on to post a 4-1 record on the week ... The Bison rallied from an 8-2 deficit to win game one 13-10 over UP-G behind two hits and two RBIs from **Chuck Ziants** and **Anthony Packer** and then scored seven runs in the sixth to pull away for a 12-3 win in game two ... Ziants went 4-for-4 with five RBIs and BC scored six times in the ninth inning to pull away for 12-5 win at Grove City Friday ... **Ryan Styche** pitched 6 1/3 solid innings and **Josh Dow** threw 2 2/3 scoreless to earn the save ... Bethany blew a 4-0 lead to lose game one to GCC, 5-4 in 8 innings, Saturday, but recovered to win the nightcap 7-2, as Packer was 2-for-3 with 2 RBI and **Ryan Meier** didn't allow an earned run in 5 1/3 innings.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-8, 3-2 PAC)



Geneva's baseball week opened with a 6-4 non-conference loss to Penn State Beaver ... Despite a solid four innings of shut-out pitching from **Caleb Kilgore**, the Golden Tornadoes could not rally past the Lions ... Friday, Geneva traveled to Saint Vincent and picked up a split against the Bearcats to move its overall record to 9-8, including a 3-2 mark in PAC play ... **Jon Bushmire** provided some punch with a pair of solo homers in the 9-5 nightcap victory ... Bushmire, **Joel Gatti** and **T.J. Lambert** each had a pair of hits in the victory ... Kilgore went the distance in game two to pick up the victory to close out a solid week on the hill ... Geneva will have a busy week coming up with six league games, beginning with a make-up game against Saint Vincent Monday at 3:30 pm at 33rd Street Field.

Grove City Wolverines (3-12, 1-2 PAC)



Grove City opened PAC play over the weekend by taking one of three games with Bethany ... Saturday, the Wolverines took game one of their doubleheader at Bethany in eight innings, 5-4 ... Senior **Brandon Durbin** belted his first collegiate homer in the top of the eighth to put the Wolverines ahead ... **Max Vickerman** fired seven innings to record the win and **Blaine Lang** notched his first collegiate save with a scoreless eighth ... **Zach Struharik** went 3-for-4 with two RBIs ... Struharik also had a pair of hits in the nightcap ... GCC opened the series with a 12-5 setback against Bethany Friday ... **Josh Sacks** went 3-for-4 with two doubles ... Freshman P **Will Chaney** threw a career-high eight innings and allowed just two earned runs ... Bethany put away the game with six ninth-inning runs.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (11-3, 1-1 PAC)



The Bearcats went 3-1 last week, including a doubleheader sweep of PSU-Altoona and a doubleheader split with Geneva to open up PAC action ... Strong pitching and timely hitting highlighted the Bearcat wins this week as starters **Mike Tedesco**, **Paul Kubeja** and **Jared Haller** all had quality outings ... Tedesco allowed just one run against PSU-A in 6.2 innings while scattering nine hits ... Kubeja allowed three runs (two earned) in tossing a complete game in his first start of the season ... Against Geneva, Haller threw his second-straight complete-game shutout and worked his scoreless innings streak to 16.2 innings ... The Bearcats posted 12-0 win in the PAC opener thanks to a 4-for-4 performance from **Erik Fichter** ... In game two, **Zack Galasso** and **Andrew Kozusko** belted back-to-back homers.

Thiel Tomcats (6-9, 0-3 PAC)



After posting a 20-6 victory in its home opener against Hiram College on Wednesday, the Tomcats dropped three-straight to Westminster over the weekend ... The Tomcats used five pitchers in their victory over Hiram, with **Cody Northcott** securing his second win of the season ... The offensive output marks the most runs for Thiel in a single contest since April 30, 2010, when the team posted 23 runs at home against Geneva ... Despite the efforts of its starting pitching against Westminster, the Tomcats combined to leave 27 runners on base in the three-game series.

Thomas More Saints (9-5, 1-2 PAC)



Thomas More went 1-3 last week as it dropped a non-conference game with Hanover in extra innings and then went 1-2 against Waynesburg in both teams' PAC opening three-game series ... Junior DH **Ryan Darner** led the Saints at the plate last week, as he batted .500 (8-for-16), including a home run, eight RBIs and two runs scored ... On the mound last week, junior **Grant Lewis** had a 2.25 ERA as he gave up six runs (two earned) on 12 hits and struck out five in eight innings ... Freshman **Tim Baldrick** had a 2.57 ERA as he gave up two earned runs in seven innings on six hits and struck out three, while sophomore **Andy Roenker** had a 0.00 ERA as he gave up nine unearned runs on 10 hits and struck out two in six innings ... Freshman OF **Nick Connor** leads the team with a .447 average.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-1, 0-0 PAC)



W&J completed its first undefeated Florida trip with five victories last week ... W&J defeated No. 6 Wisc.-Stevens Point, the highest-ranked opponent it has beaten since March 20, 2006, when it also defeated a Stevens Point team that was ranked sixth at the time in Florida ... The Presidents are off to their best start (9-1) since 2007, when they opened the season 10-1 ... W&J has a .353 (110-312) team batting average, compared to just .262 (81-309) by its opponents ... Sophomore RF **Josh Staniscia** batted .526 (10-19), including four multi-hit games last week ... Staniscia scored 11 runs and produced nine RBI ... The W&J staff has a team ERA of 3.58 ... Sophomore P **Eddie Nogay** allowed no earned runs in nine innings last week, as he earned a win against Hope and a save vs. UWSP.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (11-4, 2-1 PAC)



Waynesburg posted a winning record during a taxing week of action that included the start of its PAC schedule ... The Yellow Jackets split a doubleheader with a traditionally strong Penn St.-Behrend team on Monday before heading to Kentucky to take 2-of-3 in a PAC series at two-time defending PAC champion Thomas More ... Waynesburg hit an impressive .370 for the week and received a trio of outstanding starting pitching performances ... Senior **Ben Oviatt** improved to 5-0 with five complete-game victories in five starts on the season by going 2-0 this past week with a 1.93 ERA ... Opponents hit just .216 off the veteran, but it was start against the Saints that really stole the show ... He allowed just four singles and saw just three Thomas More base runners to reach scoring position in the 12-0 victory.

Westminster Titans (11-6, 3-0 PAC)



Westminster baseball team won its PAC opener 3-1 against Thiel on March 23 ... Senior P **Justin Prejsnar** improved to 3-0 on the season by giving up one run on 10 hits, five strikeouts, and a walk in the complete game performance ...
