Sophomore P John Astfalk earned the win on the mound Monday after limiting Carroll to five hits and one earned run ... Grove City opened 2005 with seven games in Fort Myers, Fla. last week ... The Wolverines opened 0-5 before sweeping Plymouth State (N.H.) Thursday ... Junior Erik Arnesen fanned 10 batters to earn the win in the opener while Jarrett Wiggers got the win in the nightcap ... Dan Aloisio pitched two scoreless innings of relief while Ryan Carr picked up the save ... It was Wiggers' first collegiate win ... Jerry Ott went 3-for-3 with a double against Carroll while Chris Schwamberger rapped three hits in the nightcap against Plymouth State ... Schwamberger also swiped two bases ... Four of **Joel Diller**'s eight hits last week went for extra bases, including a homer and two triples.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg hosted Pitt-Greensburg for a doubleheader Thursday for its home opener ... After posting a 5-0 shutout victory in game one, the Yellow Jackets dropped the nightcap, 9-5 ... Junior P Justin Schrader pitched his secondstraight complete game shutout and tied his career high of 14 strikeouts against UP-G in the first game ... The Bobcats managed just one walk and four hits against the Yellow Jacket ace ... Waynesburg jumped out to a 3-0 lead during the second inning of game one when freshmen OFs Bryce Allen and Brendon Steele drove in runs ... The Bobcats took an early 4-0 lead in game twobefore the Yellow Jackets responded with a threerun first, highlighted by Steele's two-run home run to right field.
