He was 4-for-5 at the plate in a 7-0 non-league win over Hiram, then was a perfect 3-for-3 with a pair of extra-base hits and an RBI and the Tomcats snapped Westminster's 12-game win streak with a 6-1 home win Sunday.

Kubeja earned his first career complete game shutout for the Bearcats in a 4-0 win at PAC rival Geneva Saturday. In seven innings, he scattered seven hits (all singles) and walked just one while striking out five. He went to a three-ball count just twice and forced Geneva (batting .350 and scoring 8.5 rpg entering the contest) into 14 ground ball outs and just one flyout.

Also nominated was senior **Mike Kochman** of Bethany, sophomore **Erich Locker** of Grove City, junior **Brad Bates** of Thiel, freshman **Randall Risch** of W&J, senior **Jesse Gonzalez** of Waynesburg, and junior **Patrick Mulligan** of Westminster.

TOP 25: Defending PAC Champion Thomas More moved up seven spots from #25 to #18 in last week's D3Baseball.com Top 25 national poll ... Westminster was listed among others receiving votes ... The Titans tied the program record for best start at 12-0 (tying the 1995 team) Saturday before falling at Thiel Sunday.

The Bison bats were held quiet in the opening game of the Waynesburg series, as BC managed just 5 hits in a 4-1 loss ... **Mike Muklewicz** was shouldered with the loss after allowing four runs (three earned) in six innings ... Bethany rallied from a four-run deficit to pull out a 7-6 victory in 10 innings in Saturday's first game, as **Brad Kubis** hit a two-run single for the winning runs ... **Eric Fudala** had two hits and three RBIs in the win ... Four BC errors in the nightcap opened the door for eight unearned runs and Bethany couldn't recover, falling 9-5 ... Kubis and Zarewicz both had two hits.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (10-5)



In the first PAC baseball action of the season, the Golden Tornadoes dropped a doubleheader to Saint Vincent College by scores of 4-0 and 8-1 ... Geneva's bats were silenced by the Bearcats after coming into the twin bill with a team batting average of .350 ... **Mike Suluva** posted four hits in the doubleheader, but Geneva could not solve the Bearcats on the mound to put hits together ... Geneva begins the new week with an overall record of 10-5 as it gets set for a very busy six-game week within the PAC.

Grove City Wolverines (5-7, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City split a doubleheader with visiting Case Western Reserve Tuesday at Jack Behringer Field ... GCC dropped the opener 15-9 but rebounded for a 2-1 win in game two ... In game two, sophomore **Erick Locker** allowed no earned runs in six innings and **Zach Butler** pitched a scoreless seventh for the save ... **Marcus Magister** doubled in the win ... In the opener, **Andrew Patterson** went 3-for-5 ... **Scott Moran** and **Dan Quirk** both doubled twice ... **Josh Sacks** and **Kyle Wolff** both doubled and singled ... Inclement weather forced the postponement of Grove City's weekend series with Thomas More Friday and Saturday ... Those games have been rescheduled for April ... The Wolverines open PAC play at Saint Vincent Tuesday ... This weekend, Grove City faces Bethany in a three-game set.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (7-8, 0-0 PAC)



SVC posted a 3-0 week, defeating Pitt-Greensburg on Wednesday before sweeping a road pair at Geneva Saturday, as opponents mustered just one earned run in 23 innings ... In the UP-G contest, **Mike Hustava**, **Joe Aul**, **Grant Krally**, and **Zach Galasso** each had two hits, with Hustava tallying a double, run scored, and three RBIs ... **Erik Fichter** started and worked six innings, scattering six hits with six strikeouts to earn the win, before giving way to **Matt Tyson**, who took the save ... In Saturday's opener with Geneva, a 4-0 win, **Paul Kubeja** threw the first complete game shutout of his career, scattering seven singles while striking out five ... After suffering a heart-breaking extra-inning defeat in game one on Saturday, the Jackets rebounded to take game two against the Bison 9-5 ... Junior **Noah Pust** belted a three-run homer in the first inning to set the tone for the victory, while junior **Ben Oviatt** worked all seven innings to pick up the win on the mound.
