Arnesen was 2-0 in a pair of starts against PAC opponents last week, allowing one earned run on seven hits while striking out 17 batters in 15 innings (0.60 ERA). He posted a three-hit 3-0 shutout at Bethany, then allowed four hits in 8+ innings on a 3-1 win at Thiel.

Bartholomew threw a gem vs. Denison, going 8 1/3 and allowing just one unearned run on five hits while striking out seven ... RF **Milton Joyner** had a double and scored both runs.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 3-3 overall and 1-2 in PAC action ... After a 19-7 win vs. Lake Erie Monday, the Tomcats fell at home to Grove City 3-1 Friday ... After suffering a 6-2 loss in game one Saturday at GCC, the Tomcats rebounded to record a 5-4 win in game two ... Thiel

Junior LF **Nate Hopkins** helped seal the comeback with a two-out, two-run homer in the top of the seventh which gave the Presidents an

8-7 lead ... Junior P **John Astfalk** earned the win in relief after tossing two perfect innings ... Sophomore DH **Ryan Gregg** singled home the game-winning run in the second game versus Westminster Saturday ... Gregg finished the game 4-for-5 with three RBI, while sophomore CF **Justin Benson** collected three hits and scored twice ... Engoglia picked up one save this week, with three strikeouts in two innings.
