Tuesday, he fired the first complete game and shutout of his career by firing a one-hitter with no walks and four strikeouts in a 1-0 blanking at Geneva. Sunday, he posted a no decision after allowing two runs (one earned) on seven hits with one walk and five strikeouts in 6 2/3 innings in a 3-2 W&J road win at PAC rival Saint Vincent.

Geneva OF **TJ Lambert** hit .409 (9-for-22) with eight RBIs in a 2-4 week.

## Bethany Bison (7-11, 4-7 PAC)



A busy week concluded with the Bison posting a 2-5 record ... CF **Derek**

**Miller** drove in four and DH Chuck Ziants scored three runs in the first game, but the Bison were swept at Thomas More 11-7 and 5-1 ... Bethany scored seven runs in the second and third innings to overcome an early deficit to beat Penn State-Beaver 19-11 in the first game of a twinbill ... **Brad Kubis** had a career-high five RBIs and Juls Leto knocked in four, including a two-run homer ... BC suffered a 15-8 loss in game 2, which was topped after 5 1/3 innings because of darkness ... Bethany took the opening game vs. Waynesburg, 9-3 ... **TJ Zarewicz** had three RBIs and Kubis and **Nate Tieman** both drove home a pair ... The Bison lost both ends of a tightly contested DH at Waynesburg Saturday.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (11-12, 5-6 PAC)



Geneva was suffering through a four-game losing streak despite solid pitching from sophomore **Mike Jefferies** ... Jefferies was the hard luck loser in a 1-0 loss to W&J Tuesday, and then dropped a heartbreaking 2-1 decision to Thiel Saturday in game one of that DH ... The Golden Tornadoes rebounded in game two with a 9-5 victory over the Tomcats ... The week began with one of the craziest games in school history as Geneva defeated Saint Vincent 21-20 on 33rd Street ... The game featured a 13-run first inning by the Golden Tornadoes that was highlighted by a grand slam from **TJ Lambert** and a three-run home from **Noah Medich** ... Lambert finished with six RBIs in the victory ... Another busy week is upcoming for the Golden Tornadoes with four PAC games.

## Grove City Wolverines (4-16, 2-6 PAC)



The Wolverines played five PAC games on the road last week, going 1-4 ... Friday, a fast start propelled the Wolverines to a 16-11 win at Thomas More ... **Tom Hawley** homered, doubled and singled in the win while **Kyle Shock** also homered ... **Zach Struharik** went 3-for-5 while **Brandon Durbin** doubled twice ... **Will Chaney** pitched into the sixth, earning his first collegiate win ... Saturday, the Wolverines dropped a 4-2 decision and a 6-4 verdict at TMC ... Grove City brought the go-ahead run to the plate in both games in the seventh inning ... **Max Vickerman** threw a complete game in the opener, allowing three earned runs in six innings ... Tuesday, GCC fell at Westminster, 7-2 and 8-4 ... Sophomore **Randen Schleiden** started all five games during the week and hit .450 (9-for-20) ... Grove City hosts Westminster Wednesday.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (14-6, 4-4 PAC)



SVC started last week with an action-packed, 21-20 loss at Geneva ... After trailing 13-2 in the first inning, the Bearcats rallied to tie the score twice, but fell in the bottom of the ninth ... The two teams combined for 41 runs, 35 hits, 25 walks and eight errors in the game ... The Bearcats rebounded with a home sweep of Waynesburg the following day, 9-8 in game one and a walk-off, 6-5, win in extra innings during the second game ... In the first game, junior LHP **Jared Haller** improved to 4-0 on the season in relief following a sixth inning HR by junior OF **Andrew Kozusko** ... In the second game, senior **Mike Hustava** and junior **Grant Krally** each smoked bases-loaded singles to push across two runs and seal the win. Saturday, after dropping the first game at W&J, Haller went to distance in extra innings to improve to 5-0.

## Thiel Tomcats (9-11, 2-4 PAC)



The Tomcats finished the week 3-2 ... After notching a 7-5 extra-inning win at La Roche Tuesday, they took 2-of-3 from Geneva before falling at Mount Union 2-1 Sunday ... **Alex Yoder** collected his first collegiate victory in relief of SP **Nick Rossmiller** against La Roche while **Kyle Mohr** earned the first save of his career after entering with no outs and the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th ... **Billy Roosa** registered his second four-hit day of the season in Friday's win over Geneva while starter **Brad Bates** notched his first victory of the season, allowing three earned runs on eight hits with three strikeouts in 8.0 innings ... Rossmiller improved to 4-1 on the season with Saturday's game one win against Geneva, going 7.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits and a season-high tying five strikeouts.

## Thomas More Saints (13-6, 5-3 PAC)



Thomas More went 4-1 last week as it swept a doubleheader with Bethany and took two of three games from Grove City ... The Saints had four players bat over as junior SS **David Kennett** batted .500 with two doubles and two RBIs; junior RF **Ryan Darner** batted .444 with a home run, a double and four RBIs; senior 1B **Andrew Thole** batted .438 with a home run, a triple, three doubles and six RBIs; and sophomore CF **Cody Makin** batted .400 with two doubles and two RBIs ... On the mound last week, junior **David Etscheid** had a 0.77 ERA with a 1-0 record and recorded three saves in 11.2 innings, including a save in game one against Bethany and then the start and win in game two ... For the season, freshman OF **Nick Connor** leads the team in batting with a .410 average (25-for-46) with 11 RBIs.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-2, 4-1 PAC)



W&J began PAC play with wins in 4-of-5 games last week ... Senior P **Dave Trushel** tossed a pair of complete games and earned a pair of victories ... He has thrown four complete games this spring, more than doubling his career total to seven ... Trushel moved into a tie with **Mike Trumpower** '09 for second on the all-time innings pitched list at W&J with 213.2 ... Trushel needs just one more victory to tie Trumpower for second all-time in wins ... Sophomore **Eddie Nogay** tossed a one-hit shutout against Geneva Tuesday, the first shutout of his career ... Nogay's streak of consecutive innings without allowing an earned run came to an end at 23.1 on Sunday ... Sophomore RF **Josh Staniscia** capped a 3-4 day with a go-ahead home run in the eighth inning on Sunday against SVC.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (13-7, 4-4 PAC)



A full week of competition got off to a rough start for Waynesburg, but ended on a high note Saturday ... After dropping a pair of one-run contests, including a 6-5 extra-inning affair, at Saint Vincent, the Yellow Jackets came up on the short end of a 9-3 defeat at the hands of Bethany Friday ... However, after celebrating Senior Day, the Jackets rebounded to .500 in PAC action by sweeping a seven-inning DH from the Bison to wrap up the week ... Waynesburg had to claw its way out of early deficits in both victories, including a 4-0 hole that the Jackets fell into during the opener of Saturday's twin-bill ... After tying the game up and sending it into extra innings, junior RF **Adam Horning** drilled a walk-off single for a 5-4 victory ... Horning did it again in game two by teeing off on a three-run homer that turned a 2-0 deficit into a 3-2 lead.

## Westminster Titans (14-7, 5-0 PAC)



Westminster swept its doubleheader against Grove City on March 27 by scores of 8-2 and 7-4, respectively ... Sophomore P **Ron Sullivan** improved to 2-0 by giving up two runs off five hits in a complete game ... Hanicak struck out six and gave up three hits in 4.1 scoreless innings on his way to his second victory ... Perrotta had two doubles, two runs, an RBI, and a stolen base in the game ...
