A week away from the diamond didn't hurt Bethany last week as the team swept two from Muskingum (5-2, 14-7) and notched a win over preseason ranked Denison (8-7) ... Bethany used the strong pitching of starters Adam Martin and Ryan Simmons to power past the Muskies ... Martin went 5.2 innings despite picking up a no-decision to pace the Bison in the first game, while Simmons went five innings and picked up his second win of the season to finish out the day ... Aaron Meadows went 2of-3 with three RBIs while Tim Goetz went 3-of-6 with two RBIs ... Against Denison, Goetz led the crew, going 2-of-4 with three RBIs while Zach Duncan earned the victory from the mound.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted a 2-1 record in non-conference play last week as they swept Mount Union, but dropped a 5-4 decision at La Roche ... Sophomore SS Nick Fiorilli led W&J to a sweep of Mount Union with five hits and four RBIs Tuesday ... W&J took a 3-1 lead in the first inning of game one when freshman DH Ryan Gregg belted a three-run homer ... The Presidents then struck for five runs in the bottom of the second highlighted by RBI singles from sophomores 2B Chris Varacallo and RF Ron Mitko ... Junior P Dan Yokitis went five innings to earn the win ... Fiorilli was 3-for-3 with four RBI in the second game, while freshman CF Justin Benson was 2-for-3 with two RBIs ... Freshman LF Greg Barton also notched two hits.

Grove City opened PAC action Friday afternoon with a 13-4 loss to visiting Westminster ... Michael McMillen went 3-for-3 with a pair of doubles in the defeat while Jerry Ott cracked a two-run homer ... Luke Lester hurled six innings, but took the loss ... Dan Aloisio pitched three innings in relief, the longest outing of his career ... Grove City managed just six hits in its doubleheader at NAIA St. Vincent Thursday ... Jarrett Wiggers and Neil Hoagland were each tagged with losses in the doubleheader ... Ott and Ritter are the only two Grove City players to start all 10 games ... Fourteen different position players have started at least one game this season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped its PAC opener to Thiel, 11-2, Friday after failing to post a win against St. Vincent in a doubleheader, 12-4, 2-2 ... The Yellow Jackets tied the game against the Tomcats in the second inning when freshman Matt Popiolkowski scored on a wild pitch ... Popiolkowski and classmate Bryce Allen each collected two hits in the loss ... The venue of the twinbill against St. Vincent was changed due to weather conditions in Waynesburg ... The Bearcats roughed up junior Justin Schrader for eight earned runs in the first game ... Brian Gerginski, Mike Majetic and Allen each posted two hits in the first game ... Waynesburg tied St. Vincent in the nightcap after the game was called due to darkness after six innings.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats ran their win streak to five games after taking down Waynesburg in their PAC opener Friday 11-2 ... Junior 3B **Bob Flukas** was 3-for-5 with a pair of home runs and six RBIs ... Senior starter **Keith Jackson** earned the win on the mound for Thiel, allowing one run on six hits with four strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work ... With the win Jackson improves to 4-1 on the season ... Junior LF **Mark Nightingale** finished 3-for-5 at the dish with a pair of doubles, two RBIs and two runs scored ... Junior 1B **Ryan Betzler** went 2-for-2 with a pair of walks, three runs scored and two RBIs.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opened PAC play Friday with a 13-4 win at Grove City ... Junior Brenton Gilmore garnered the pitching win, improving to 3-0 after pitching seven innings, allowing three runs on seven hits with six walks and eight strikeouts ... The big hit for the Titans was a pinch-hit grand slam home run by freshman OF Don Womeldorff in the seventh, after senior OF Brooks LeViere had hit a two-run shot in the first ...
