Raiti batted .500 (3-for-6) for the Bison in a doubleheader sweep of PAC foe Westminster Saturday, including a threerun home run which provided the game-winning runs in a 5-2 win win. He scored three runs and added a stolen base.

Trumpower earned two of W&J's three wins, firing three hitless relief innings in a 6-5, 11-inning win over Mount Aloysius before throwing six innings of five-hit ball in a 5-3 win over Grove City. He allowed one run on five hits with seven strikeouts in nine innings of work during the week.

# **Bethany Bison**

The Bison remained undefeated in the PAC with a home doubleheader sweep of Westminster Saturday ... The Bison received strong performances out of pitchers Adam Martin and Todd Welsh ... Martin registered a complete game against the Titans, allowing just six hits and two earned runs, while striking out five and walking two in a 12-2 victory ... Welsh went 5.1 innings in game two, allowing six hits and one earned run ... Matt Rait i got the final five outs in earning his first save ... Raiti hit .500 (3-for-6) in the two games, with a three run home run in game two, and three runs scored ... D.J. Hynes and lan Dunn also went deep in the second game, as all five Bison runs came from the long ball.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Through 13 games, W&J has already surpassed its season win totals from each of the past three years ... W&J is riding a five-game winning streak, its longest since last claiming the PAC Championship in 1997 ... The Presidents opened up their new home, Ross Memorial Park, on Tuesday with a 6-5 victory over Mount Aloysius in 11 innings ... Freshman 2B Chris Varacallo doubled home freshman C Warren Stowe for the game-winning run ... Freshman P Mike Trumpower got the win after tossing three scoreless innings in relief ... Freshman 1B Sam Mann blasted the first two home runs in Ross Memorial Park history and drove in four runs ... Trumpower and Mann combined to hold Grove City to three runs on 11 hits in 13 innings, while fanning 13 Sat.

## Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened PAC play with three tight contests away from home last week ... Jerry Ott led the Wolverines against Westminster with a homer and five RBI while Joel Diller went 3-for-5 with two doubles ... Luke Lester earned the win in relief while Erik Arnesen got the final nine outs for the save ... Ryan Carr fired a complete game against W&J Saturday in the first game of a doubleheader but took the loss ... Chris Hull fell to 1-2 after taking the loss in the second game ... Neither team committed an error in the doubleheader ... Grove City had won 17 of the last 18 meetings with the Presidents ... Grove City will look to improve to 2-2 in the conference Monday against Washington & Jefferson.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

A total of seven games were rained out this week for Waynesburg ... The Jackets March 30 home game against Penn State-Altoona was postponed until April 27 at Altoona ... The second non-conference tilt of the week at Muskingum was also postponed (to April 7) ... Waynesburg's weekend series with Thiel was pushed back to a home doubleheader on April 5 and one game at Thiel on April 12.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Due to inclement weather the Tomcats managed to play only game last week, a 9-7 win over non-conference foe Mt. Union Wednesday ... After trailing 7-3 going into the sixth, the Tomcats rallied with four runs in the sixth and two more in the seventh to claim the non-conference win ... Sophomore Joe Link picked up his second win in as many games, pitching three scoreless innings in relief ... Junior Keith Jackson got his first save of the season, pitching the final inning of the contest ... Mt. Union held a 7-3 lead over the Tomcats going into the sixth ... Brett Bell paced the Tomcats offensively, going 3-for-5 with a pair of RBIs ... Sophomore C Kinsey Henderson finished with two hits and two RBIs.
