Herringshaw was 2-0 with an 0.00 ERA in PAC action, as Grove City went 5-0 against league foes for the week. He pitched two scoreless innings of relief to earn the win in a 12-9 PAC victory over Waynesburg Wednesday, then fired a complete-game two-hit road shutout in a 4-0 win over the Yellow Jackets the next day. For the week, he allowed four hits and walked one with five strikeouts in 9.0 innings pitched.

Also nominated was freshman Zach Kozlowski of Bethany, junior Josh Russell of Thiel, sophomore Paul Uhl of Thomas More, junior Pat Kennedy of W&J, freshman Anthony Longo of Waynesburg, and freshman Kyle Allen of Westminster.

SWEEPS WEEK: PAC action last weekend was a lopsided affair, with three series sweeps ... Grove City took three from Waynesburg midweek, while over the weekend Thomas More swept Geneva and W&J swept Bethany ... In the one tight series, Thiel rallied from a Friday loss to sweep Westminster Saturday.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More set several school records in its 32-0 home victory over Geneva Friday, including runs (32) and hits (30) in a single game ... Thiel posted walk-off hits in both of its wins vs. Westminster Saturday: Brock Porter on a two-run single in game one and Justin Scarpitti on a three-run homer in game two.

AROUND THE PAC: The PAC boasts two national statistical leaders through games of March 28: Bethany freshman RP **Brad Kubis** leads NCAA Division III in saves with six, while Washington & Jefferson senior OF **Neil Pascarella** leads the nation in home runs per game (0.56).

Bethany Bison (9-5, 1-4 PAC)

Bethany opened PAC play by slipping past Thiel 5-4, but dropped



the nightcap 5-0 and then fell in all three games against W&J over the weekend ... Zach Kozlowski threw 5 2/3 strong innings and Adam Nyswaner and Brad Kubis finished off the Thiel win, with Kubis getting his seventh save of the year to tie the BC single-season record ... Kubis also led the charge at the plate with two hits and three RBIs and 2B Eric Fudala had three hits and knocked in one ... Fudala led the Bison in hitting for the week at .467 (8for-15) and Kubis hit .421 (8-for-19) with 5 RBIs ... In the first game with W&J Friday, C T.J. Zarewicz was 3-for-3 with two doubles ... Kubis had five hits, two RBIs and two runs scored in the twinbill with the Presidents Saturday.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-12)

It was a forgettable week for the Geneva baseball GOLDEN TORNADOES team as it dropped five

straight PAC games and saw its current losing streak reach eight games ... The Golden Tornadoes, who opened the season at 8-4, have fallen to 8-12 on the year ... Each of the eight games during the slide have come against PAC opponents, including a pair against Washington & Jefferson this week and three straight at Thomas More over the weekend ... Only twice in the first 15 games had Geneva allowed an opponent to score in double figures ... That has not been the case lately as opponents have scored in double figures in five straight.

Grove City Wolverines (8-7, 4-1 PAC)

Grove City surged to the top of the PAC last week by sweeping

Waynesburg in a three-game series .. Wednesday, GCC rallied for a 12-9 home win over the Yellow Jackets ... Tyler Thompson's two-run single in the eighth broke a 9-9 tie ... Senior Mike Herringshaw pitched two innings of relief and earned the win ... The next day, Herringshaw threw a two-hit shutout in a 4-0 win at Waynesburg ... Marcus Magister belted a two-run homer in the 7th to seal the win ... In the nightcap, Andrew Patterson's two-run single in the seventh broke a 2-2 tie ... Junior Cory Metcalf earned the win after firing six innings ... Freshman Zach Butler pitched the seventh for his first save ... The week began with a pair of wins at Saint Vincent Tuesday ... Grove City will play four straight days this week, includign a Thursday clash with Westminster.

Saint Vincent **Bearcats** (10-6)

The Bearcats' lone action of the week came on Tuesday,

as they hosted a doubleheader with Grove City ... Saint Vincent led in each game, before Grove City posting a pair of comeback wins, topping the hosts 5-3 in nine innings in the opener, before clinching the sweep with a 7-3 win in the nightcap ... In the opener, Matt Tyson earned the tough no decision on the mound, going seven innings and scattering five hits with five strikeouts, allowing just two earned runs ... Zack Galasso went 4-for-6 in the twinbill, with two doubles and two RBIs, lifting his average to .444, while Zach Bush and Mike Hustava each had three hits in the doubleheader ... SVC now faces its busiest week of the season, playing six games in the next six days, including PAC matchups with Grove City (Wed) and Geneva (Fri/Sat).

Thiel **Tomcats** (11-9, 4-4 PAC)

Thiel finished the week strong with a sweep of

league-leading Westminster Saturday, taking the twinbill with scores of 12-11 and 13-10 ... Both games ended in dramatic fashion, with freshman C Brock Porter driving in the tying and winning runs on a single in the first game and senior 1B Justin Scarpitti delivering a three-run homer to win the daycap ... Junior CF Luke Johnson went a combined 9-for-10 on the day with five runs scored and two RBIs ... Tuesday. Josh Russell tossed a completegame three-hitter to give Thiel its first win of the week, 5-0, over Bethany at Tomcat Park ... Russell, who improved to 2-1 on the season, struck out 11 Bison in the seven inning affair to avenge a. 5-4. loss earlier in the afternoon ... Thiel returns to action on Wednesday when they visit Bethany at 3:30 p.m.

Thomas More Saints (9-9, 0-0 PAC)

The Saints went 3-1 last week as they fell at Capi-

tal in a non-conference game and then swept Geneva in a three-game PAC series ... For the week, Thomas More had three players bat over .600 as junior C Nick Ryan hit .778 (7for-9) with a double, four RBIs and seven runs scored; freshman SS David Kennett hit .714 (10-for-14) with a double, a triple, five RBIs and seven runs scored: and junior LF Max Robbins batted .688 (11-for-16) with three doubles, 10 RBIs and six runs scored ... On the mound last week, sophomore Paul Uhl had a 0.00 earned run average as he pitched five innings, giving up only two hits and striking out seven ... For the season, Robbins and Kennett are both batting over .400 as Robbins is batting .463 with 19 RBI and Kennett is batting .400 with 14 RBI.
