# Bethany Bison

ends of the twinbill, 11-0 and 12-4 ... CF **Rich Majewski** and LF **Aaron Meadows** both went 3-6 in the games ... The first W&J game saw junior **Brett Bartholomew** hurl a four-hitter for his first career shutout in a 2-0 victory ... He struck out six and walked four as he ran his streak without giving up an earned run to 15 1/3 consecutive innings ... In Sunday's finale, Bethany held 3-0 and 5-2 leads but couldn't hold them in a 12-7 loss ... Majewski had three hits, while Meadows and RF **Ian Edwards** both had two hits and two RBI.



## Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished the week 3-0 with a series sweep of Westminster ... The Tomcats needed seven innings in each game of the doubleheader to pick up wins of 5-4 and 9-8, then posted 16 hits in a 20-3 win Sunday ... Junior SS **Ben Cobler**'s fielder's choice scored freshman 2B **Kyle** 

Richardson in the bottom of the seventh of game one, while freshman CF Dan Morrison's RBI single in the seventh scored senior RF Brett Bell in game two ... Freshman P Nick Myers improved to 3-1 with the game one win after relieving senior P Rich McNeal ... Freshman P Mark Brewer earned the game two win ... In game three freshman P Gary Kirchenbauer allowed three runs on seven hits with three strikeouts in 7.0 innings, improving to 4-1.
