Wiand led the PAC-leading Titans to a 3-1 week vs. league foes by batting .625 (10-for-16) with two home runs, five doubles, seven runs scored, 11 RBIs and a slugging percentage of 1.313. After pounding out a 2-1-4 win at Grove City, Westminster took 2-of-3 against archrival Geneva to remain one game ahead of W&J in the PAC standings.

Also nominated was junior IF **Brad Kubis** of Bethany, junior SS **Brad Burkardt** of Saint Vincent, junior 2B **Eric King** of Thiel, sophomore OF **Cody Makin** of Thomas More, senior SS **Aaron Klinec** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior 1B **Bobby Hartman** of Waynesburg.

In game two of a double-header Saturday against archrival Westminster, Jeffreys fired a complete-game three-hit shut-out with seven strikeouts to lead the GTs to a 2-0 victory. It marked the first conference loss for the league-leading Titans (who had totaled a combined 52 runs in their previous three wins) this season.

Also nominated was freshman **Ryan Meier** of Bethany, junior **Jared Haller** of Saint Vincent, junior **Nick Rossmiller** of Thiel, junior **David Etscheid** of Thomas More, sophomore **Eddie Nogay** of Washington & Jefferson, senior **Ben Oviatt** of Waynesburg, and sophomore **Ron Sullivan** of Westminster.



TWO ON TOP: As we near the midway point of the PAC schedule, Westminster and Washington & Jefferson remain in a battle for the top spot in the standings ... After three PAC wins, the Titans dropped their first league game to Geneva Saturday 2-0, but remained one game ahead of the Presidents when W&J dropped a 6-3 decision to Bethany.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior P **Jared Haller** is now 6-0 for Saint Vincent after a win over Thomas More ... Sophomore **Mike Jeffreys** fired a three-hitter with seven K's in Geneva's win over Westminster ... Junior 1B **Bobby Hartman** hit .385 with a .769 slugging percentage for 2-2 Waynesburg ... Westminster sophomore P **Ron Sullivan** improved to 3-0 with a three-hitter at Grove City.

AROUND THE PAC: W&J P **Eddie Nogay** has allowed one earned run in his last 32 2/3 innings ... **Alex Evans** posted an inside-the-park home run in Bethany's 6-3 win over W&J ... Sophomore OF **Cody Makin** hit .533 (8-for-15) with a double and three RBIs for 2-2 Thomas More ... Thiel junior P **Nick Rossmiller** improved to 5-1 in a 7-3 win over Waynesburg.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (8-14, 5-10 PAC)



Bethany dropped its first three games of the week before ending on a high note with a 6-3 triumph at W&J ... The Bison did not have a hit in the second game against W&J until the fifth inning, but they rallied with five runs in the fifth and one more in the seventh ... **Ryan Meier** threw 5 2/3 strong innings for the win and **Alex Evans** had an inside-the-park homer, 2 RBI and 2 runs scored ... **Tanner Werkmann** had a 2-run double in game one, but W&J pounded out a 10-4 win ... In the series opener, W&J won 14-6 despite **Nate Tieman** & **Derek Miller** going 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored ... The first game of the week saw Thomas More win a 16-2 contest over the Bison ... **Brad Kubis** had three of BC's four hits and drove in one.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (12-15, 6-9 PAC)



Westminster came into Saturday's double-header with a perfect record in PAC play ... The Titans defeated Geneva 16-9 Thursday and continued their onslaught with a 15-5 victory in game one Saturday ... Enter Geneva pitching ace **Mike Jeffreys**, who more than cooled off Westminster with a 2-0 complete game shutout ... The Titans had scored 52 runs in their previous three games and were held to just three hits from Jeffreys ... **Noah Medich** picked up a pair of RBIs in the game one loss but came up with an even bigger RBI for Geneva's first run in the nightcap ... **TJ Lambert** also knocked in a run, giving Geneva all the offense it would need ... **Jon Bushmire** also had a solid week with two hits at W&J Wednesday before posting a 4-for-5 day Thursday at Westminster.

Grove City Wolverines (4-17, 2-7 PAC)



Grove City fell to Westminster Wednesday in the Wolverines' lone action of the week ... Freshman DH **J.R. Willard** tripled and singled, junior first baseman **Kyle Shock** tripled and junior LF **Zach Struharik** doubled ... Freshman **Blaine Lang** pitched two scoreless innings of relief ... The Wolverines will host Allegheny Tuesday in non-conference action at 4 p.m. ... Grove City will then square off with Geneva this weekend ... Friday's game will be at Geneva and Grove City will host the doubleheader Saturday ... It will be the Wolverines' first home doubleheader of the season ... The teams split a doubleheader in Beaver Falls April 30, 2011 ... Seven of Grove City's first nine conference games have been on the road.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-8, 6-6 PAC)



The Bearcats went 2-2 last week, including taking the season series from Thomas More for the first time since joining the PAC ... After dropping a 9-4 decision at Waynesburg to start the week in a game where junior SS **Brad Burkardt** belted his third homer of the season, the Bearcats captured the first two games of the three-game set with the Saints ... In the nine-inning tilt, the Bearcats posted a 10-1 win behind 7.1 solid innings from senior **Paul Kubeja** ... Offensively, senior C **Erik Fichter** notched his second homer of the season en route to a 3-for-4 performance with three RBIs while Burkardt finished 3-for-5 with three RBIs and two runs ... In the first game of Thursday's DH, junior LHP **Jared Haller** improved to 6-0 with his fourth complete game ... Senior 1B **Mike Hustava** launched a solo homer.

Thiel Tomcats (11-14, 4-5 PAC)



The Tomcats took two of three from PAC rival Waynesburg last week, but dropped a pair of non-league matchups with Allegheny (7-5) on April 3 and Penn St.-Behrend (L 8-4) on April 9 ... **Eric Steinger** posted his team-best 13th multiple hit game, while **Nick Rossmiller** improved to 5-1 as Thiel earned a 7-3 victory over the Yellow Jackets on April 5 ... Steinger finished 3-for-4 with three RBIs while Rossmiller threw 8.0 strong innings and allowed three runs on five hits with four strikeouts ... After suffering a 4-1 game one loss at Waynesburg -Saturday, a game two complete-game effort by **Bobby Hillier** and a seventh inning RBI single by **Eric King** helped the Tomcats earn the split with a 5-4 victory ... Hillier made his first start of the season and gave up four runs (one earned) on six hits in the victory.

Thomas More Saints (15-8, 7-5 PAC)



Thomas More 2-2 last week against PAC opponents ... The Saints had three players bat over .500 as sophomore OF **Cody Makin** batted .533 with a double, three RBIs and two runs scored; sophomore 3B **Travis Miller** batted .500 with two RBIs and a run scored and junior P/OF **Grant Lewis** batted .500 with an RBI and two runs scored ... On the mound last week, the Saints were led by junior **David Etscheid** with a 1.29 ERA as he had a complete game three-hit, one-run win against Saint Vincent ... For the season, Miller and Makin lead the team in batting with a .412 average, as Miller has nine RBIs and four doubles and Makin has a home run, a triple, four doubles and nine RBI ... The Saints are led on the mound by Etscheid, who has a 1.55 ERA, a 3-0 record and three saves in 29.0 innings.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (16-3, 7-2 PAC)



W&J moved to 16-3 on the season after a 3-1 week ... Washington & Jefferson completed a three-game season sweep of Geneva with a 13-7 victory Wednesday ... The Presidents took 2-of-3 against Bethany over the weekend ... W&J is one of just four NCAA Division III schools in the country to rank in the top 50 in team batting, ERA and fielding percentage ... Senior SS **Aaron Klinec** set career-highs with four hits and five RBI against Geneva ... Senior RHP **Dave Trushel** tossed six innings and picked up his fifth victory of the spring ... Trushel now ranks second all-time in innings pitched (219.2), tied for second with 21 wins and fourth in strikeouts (131) ... Sophomore **Eddie Nogay** did not allow an earned run in six innings pitched, while earning the victory during game one.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (15-9, 6-6 PAC)



Waynesburg alternated wins and losses last week as it posted a 2-2 record before celebrating Easter ... The Yellow Jackets got the week off to a strong start by beating Saint Vincent, 9-4, Tuesday ... Junior 1B **Bobby Hartman** led the charge in the win by going 3-for-5 with two doubles, a triple and an RBI ... Senior 2B **Corey Goeggelman** added three hits of his own, all singles, while also picking up two RBIs and a run scored ... Senior LHP **Ben Oviatt** improved to 6-1 on the season after tossing seven innings to pick up the win ... The Jackets came back down to earth after dropping a road nine-inning contest to Thiel Thursday before the two teams met up again Saturday for a twinbill .. Oviatt pitched his team to a 4-1 triumph in the opener ... Four different Jackets scored runs in the victory, while three notched an RBI each in the win.

Westminster Titans (17-8, 8-1 PAC)



The Titans put on an offensive showcase as they topped Grove City 21-4 in a nine-inning PAC matchup ... The Titan offense produced 23 hits, including four home runs ... Westminster led 7-0 after three innings and then broke open the game with seven runs in the fourth ... Junior **Tyler Robinson** homered twice in the road win ... Westminster stayed perfect in the PAC after a 16-9 win over Geneva ... Senior P **Justin Prejsnar** picked up the win in seven innings to stay unbeaten at 4-0 on the season ... The Titan offense was powered by senior **Justin King**, who went 4-for-6 with three RBIs and two runs scored ... Westminster split a PAC doubleheader Saturday at Geneva ...
