Uhl earned his second PAC weekly honor of the 2010 season after posting a 2-0 record and 0.75 ERA last week, allowing one earned run on eight hits while striking out 14 batters in 12.0 innings of work.

Also nominated was sophomore **T.J. Zarewicz** of Bethany, senior **Mike Herringshaw** of Grove City, senior **Andrew Bales** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman **Anthony Longo** of Waynesburg.

W&J, TMC UNBEATEN: The top of the PAC standings has defending champion Washington & Jefferson and Thomas More both unbeaten in league play, while Grove City has a single conference loss ... The Presidents swept Westminster over the weekend, while the Saints took three from visiting Thiel.

NEWS & NOTES: Waynesburg snapped a six-game skid by going 3-1 in PAC action last week, as junior 1B **Bill Hanning** hit .615 (8-for-13) in four games ... Grove City hitters belted five home runs in a 22-7 PAC win over Saint Vincent, while Wolverine senior P **Mike Herringshaw** became GCC's all-time leader in wins with 18.

AROUND THE PAC: Geneva snapped a 10-game losing streak with a 6-5 home win over Saint Vincent Saturday ... Bethany freshman RP **Brad Kubis** continues to lead the nation in saves in NCAA D-III, while his eighth save of the year in a 7-5 win over Waynesburg broke the Bison single-season record.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (11-9, 3-6 PAC)



The Bison went 2-4 last week, with their wins coming in their final at-bat against Thiel and holding on for a 7-5 victory over Waynesburg ... In the 9-8 win over Thiel, **Chris Leasure's** three-run homer helped give BC an 8-6 lead, but the Tomcats rallied to tie the game in the 9th ... 2B **Eric Fudala** hit a leadoff single and eventually scored on a passed ball ... Leasure's home run was the 19th of his career to break the school's all-time home run record ... In the Waynesburg win, SS **Alex Evans** had three hits and three RBIs and after **T.J. Zarewicz** threw 6+ innings to raise his record to 4-2, **Brad Kubis** notched his eighth save of the year, which broke the Bethany single-season record ... Leasure hit .429 during the week (9-for-21) with two HRs, 2 doubles and nine RBIs.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-14)



The Golden Tornadoes finally got the monkey off their back and put an end to their 10-game losing streak on Saturday ... After dropping game one of Saturday's doubleheader 8-1 to Saint Vincent, Geneva responded with a 6-5 victory in the nightcap ... **Matt Baer** went six innings to earn his second victory of the season and **Phil Shallenberger** tossed a scoreless seventh inning to earn his second save of the year ... Geneva posted six runs in the first three innings and never looked back ... Shallenberger was effective at the plate as well with three hits and three runs scored in the win ... Geneva sits at 9-14 for the season with another handful of PAC contests coming up this week.

Grove City Wolverines (10-8, 4-1 PAC)



Grove City continued its midseason surge last week by winning two of three games ... Wednesday, the Wolverines accumulated 25 hits in a 22-7 win over visiting Saint Vincent ... P **Mike Herringshaw** became GCC's all-time wins leader by going six innings Wednesday ... He now has 18 career wins ... **Tyler Thompson** hit a pair of three-run homers while **Kyle Wolff** and **Marcus Magister** also homered ... At Case Western Saturday, Grove City scored six runs in the top of the seventh to pull out an 8-4 win in Game Two ... Magister tied the game with a two-run double ... Thompson followed with an RBI single ... **Cory Metcalf** pitched six innings to record the win while **Zach Butler** pitched a scoreless seventh ... In the opener, Wolff cracked a three-run homer but CWRU used a 10-run fifth inning to take control.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-9)



After opening the week with a rousing 16-8 victory over Franciscan, the Bearcats dropped three of four, to fall to 12-9 ... In the Franciscan game, SVC came back from down 6-2 after three innings to outslug the Barons the rest of the way ... **Brad Burkardt** went 5-for-6 with three RBIs, while **Erik Fichter** went 4-for-4, also with three ribbies ... **Jeff Bugajski** threw five no-hit innings of relief for the victory ... In Wednesday's 22-7 drubbing at Grove City, **Zack Galasso**, **Danny Jackson** and **Adam Miller** each had two base knocks ... SVC then split a Saturday doubleheader with longtime rival Geneva, winning 8-1 in the opener before falling 6-5 in the nightcap ... **Darren Smith** earned the victory in game one, scattering seven hits in six frames with five strikeouts ... In the nightcap, **Zach Bush** went 2-for-3 with three RBIs.

Thiel Tomcats (11-13, 4-8 PAC)



The young Thiel ballclub was on the short end of four PAC decisions last week, including a road loss to Bethany and a three-game sweep at Thomas More ... Tuesday's scheduled home game vs. Allegheny was postponed until April 21 due to inclement weather ... Two Tomcats – **Brock Porter** and **Luke Johnson** – batted .400 or better on the week ... Porter went 8-for-17 at the plate with two runs scored and four RBIs ... Johnson scored four runs and knocked in three more while going 6-for-15 ... **Phil Double** also scored four runs on the week ... Thiel takes a break from league play Thursday at Penn State-Behrend at 3 p.m. ... W&J comes to town Saturday for a 1 p.m. doubleheader at Tomcat Park, then the Presidents and Tomcats wrap their series with a 1 p.m. game in Washington Sunday.

Thomas More Saints (14-9, 3-0 PAC)



The Saints extended their season-high win streak to eight games as they went 5-0 last week ... In the streak, the Saints have scored double-digit runs in all eight games ... For the week, Thomas More had three players bat over .500 as senior 2B **Chris Fishburn** hit .684 (13-for-19) with three doubles, one triple, 13 RBIs and seven runs scored; junior LF **Max Robbins** batted .526 (10-for-19) with three doubles, five RBIs and 11 runs scored; and freshman SS **David Kennett** hit .500 (8-for-16) with three doubles, two RBIs and seven runs scored ... On the mound last week, sophomore **Paul Uhl** had a 0.75 ERA and 2-0 record in 12.0 innings pitched as he gave up five runs (one earned) on eight hits and struck out 14 ... For the season, Robbins leads the team at the plate with a .479 batting average.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-5, 6-0 PAC)



W&J is riding an eight-game win streak after posting a 5-0 record last week, including sweeping a weekend three-game PAC series vs. Westminster ... The Presidents opened up the week with a 14-11 come-from-behind victory against PSU-Behrend ... W&J trailed 8-1 after one, but outscored the Lions by the same 8-1 margin during the final three innings ... The Red & Black completed their sweep of Geneva with a 10-4 road victory Wednesday ... The Presidents then swept the Titans (5-2; 19-15; 7-6) to maintain their lead atop the PAC standings ... Junior CF **Andy Trettel** reached base in both games to extend his on-base streak to 52 games ... Trettel now owns the second-best consecutive on-base streak in NCAA Division III history and is eight games away from tying the national record.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (9-14, 5-7 PAC)



Waynesburg put itself in the thick of the race for a spot in the PAC Tournament after going 3-1 this week against league opponents ... The Yellow Jacket bats exploded in their first two wins of the week, as they scored a combined 32 runs during a 15-3 win over Westminster and a 17-6 triumph over Bethany ... Waynesburg won their third-straight in the week when the Jackets gritted out a 2-1 win over the Bison ... Junior 1B **Bill Hanning** and sophomore C **Noah Pust** led the WU offense by both hitting well over .500 ... Hanning hit .615 in three starts with two doubles, three RBIs and five runs scored ... Pust went 6-for-11 during the four games for a .545 average ... The week's top pitching was turned in by junior **Jesse Gonzalez**, who gave up one run in 8.2 innings of relief work during the Jackets' 17-6 win over Bethany.

Westminster Titans (7-11, 4-3 PAC)



Westminster lost four PAC games last week as its season-long losing streak dipped to six games, this after the Titans were once in first place in the PAC through five games ... The Titans are now in fifth place after getting swept in three games by first-place W&J, losing 5-2 at home Saturday and 19-15 and 7-6 (12 innings) on the road Sunday ... The Titans also lost 15-3 at Waynesburg Wednesday ... Sophomore 1B **Tim Wiand** led the Titans with a .571 batting average (8-for-14) and a .929 slugging percentage during the week, including 6-for-9 with a homer and a triple in two games Sunday ... Freshman 3B/P **Ty Miller** batted .438 (7-for-16) for the week, including a team-high six RBIs ... Miller hit a two-run single to put Westminster up 6-5 in the 7-6 loss to W&J ... A total of 12 Titan pitchers took the mound in the four games.
