W&J, TMC UNBEATEN: The top of the PAC standings has defending champion Washington & Jefferson and Thomas More both unbeaten in league play, while Grove City has a single conference loss ... The Presidents swept Westminster over the weekend, while the Saints took three from visiting Thiel.

NEWS & NOTES: Waynesburg snapped a sixgame skid by going 3-1 in PAC action last week, as junior 1B **Bill Hanning** hit .615 (8-for-13) in four games ... Grove City hitters belted five home runs in a 22-7 PAC win over Saint Vincent, while Wolverine senior P **Mike Herringshaw** became GCC's all-time leader in wins with 18. **AROUND THE PAC:** Geneva snapped a 10game losing streak with a 6-5 home win over Saint Vincent Saturday ... Bethany freshman RP **Brad Kubis** continues to lead the nation in saves in NCAA D-III, while his eighth save of the year in a 7-5 win over Waynesburg broke the Bison single-season record.

Bethany Bison (11-9, 3-6 PAC)

The Bison went 2-4 last week, with their wins coming in their final at-

bat against Thiel and holding on for a 7-5 victory over Waynesburg ... In the 9-8 win over Thiel, Chris Leasure's three-run homer helped give BC an 8-6 lead, but the Tomcats rallied to tie the game in the 9th ... 2B Eric Fudala hit a leadoff single and eventually scored on a passed ball ... Leasure's home run was the 19th of his career to break the school's all-time home run record ... In the Waynesburg win, SS Alex Evans had three hits and three RBIs and after T.J. Zarewicz threw 6+ innings to raise his record to 4-2, Brad Kubis notched his eighth save of the year, which broke the Bethany single-season record ... Leasure hit .429 during the week (9-for-21) with two HRs, 2 doubles and nine RBIs.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-9)



After opening the week with a rousing 16-8 victory over

Franciscan, the Bearcats dropped three of four, to fall to 12-9 ... In the Franciscan game, SVC came back from down 6-2 after three innings to outslug the Barons the rest of the way Brad Burkardt went 5-for-6 with three RBIs, while Erik Fichter went 4-for-4, also with three ribbies ... Jeff Bugajski threw five no-hit innings of relief for the victory ... In Wednesday's 22-7 drubbing at Grove City, Zack Galasso, Danny Jackson and Adam Miller each had two base knocks ... SVC then split a Saturday doubleheader with longtime rival Geneva, winning 8-1 in the opener before falling 6-5 in the nightcap ... Darren Smith earned the victory in game one, scattering seven hits in six frames with five strikeouts ... In the nightcap, Zach Bush went 2-for-3 with three RBIs.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-5, 6-0 PAC)



W&J is riding an eight-game win streak after posting a 5-0 record last week, including

sweeping a weekend three-game PAC series vs. Westminster ... The Presidents opened up the week with a 14-11 come-from-behind victory against PSU-Behrend ... W&J trailed 8-1 after one, but outscored the Lions by the same 8-1 margin during the final three innings ... The Red & Black completed their sweep of Geneva with a 10-4 road victory Wednesday
