PAC BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KEVIN CULP

Westminster College 6-3 Senior Pitcher/First Baseman Canfield, OH/Canfield H.S.

Cup fired a three-hit shutout with two walks and nine strikeouts in his only pitching outing, a 5-0 home win over W&J. At the plate, he hit .429 (6-of-14) with a double, a home run, four runs scored and two RBIs in three games.

Also nominated was junior OF/P **Matt Raiti** of Bethany, junior 2B **Jake Cuthbert** of Grove City, senior DH/1B **Jim Chester** of Thiel, freshman SS **Curt Keibler** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior DH/0F **Jason Tremblay** of Waynesburg.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 3-3 last week and managed to salvage the final game of the Thiel series ... In the two wins over Altoona, Bethany received solid pitching from Todd Welsh and Adam Martin and some timely hitting to record the sweep ... BC overcame a 2-0 deficit in the second game with a two-run double by Aaron Meadows and a two-run single by Scott Johnson in the fifth inning ... In rebounding to take the final game with Thiel, the Bison blasted four home runs, including three in a six-run fourth inning ... Matt Raiti (2-run), Billy Deer (solo), Nelson Rodriguez (3-run) and Paul Krisanda (2run) all hit long balls as the Bison built a seven-run lead ... Martin earned his second win of the week, improving to 4-2.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J capped a 2-5 week with a dramatic 9-8 come-from-behind victory over Westminster Sunday ... The Presidents trailed by as many as six runs twice, but rallied for three in the ninth to earn the win ... Freshman 1B Alexis Bonilla blooped a single into left center to score junior SS Bob Roth with two outs in the ninth to give W&J the win ... Senior CF B.J. Swartzlander led off the final frame with a solo home run, while freshman 3B Matt Mark added a sacrifice fly RBI ... Freshman hurler Tim Miller was awarded the win after allowing just one run and five hits ... Sophomore C Frank Pilato and freshman SS Curt Kiebler both collected three hits ... Kiebler hit a walk-off home run on Wednesday to lift W&J to a 5-4 win over Waynesburg.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City pulled to within one game of Westminster in the loss column by taking two of three games last week in PAC play ... Freshman LF Jerry Ott went 3for-3 with a double in the Wolverines' come-from-behind win over Westminster while junior 2B Jake Cuthbert went 3for-4 with a triple and also picked up the save in the ninth inning ... Sophomore Mike Gundy earned the relief win against Westminster, his first of the season ... Freshman SS Mike Ritter belted a pair of two-run homers against Waynesburg Saturday as Grove City earned a split ... Junior Chris Hull picked up the victory by allowing one earned run in five innings.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was 3-3 for the week in PAC action ... After Tuesday's 11-0 win over W&J, Waynesburg split a doubleheader against W&J on Wednesday ... The Jackets won the first game 14-4 when Jason Tremblay went 4 for 4 ... Eric Holt collected two of the three Jacket wins during the week and allowed only one run and struck out 12 batters in 14 innings ... Holt and George Taylor each belted home runs in the Jackets victory over Grove City on Saturday ... Taylor, who started the second game of a doubleheader Saturday against Grove City, suffered his first loss of the season after amassing a PAC-best 6-0 record ... Tremblay was 13 of 24 for the week with 11 runs scored and is now batting .422.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 5-1 last week, 3-1 in PAC action ... In the Tomcats non-conference sweep of Penn State Behrend (8-0, 7-6 (8)) sophomore 2B Jon Spencer finished 4-for-5 with three RBI's and two runs scored ... Senior 1B Randy Chiquelin hit his sixth homerun of the season in the Tomcats 16-6 win over Waynesburg, finishing 2-for-4 with three runs and a pair of RBI's ... Thiel swept a PAC DH against Bethany, winning 4-2 in the opener and 6-3 in game two ... Senior DH Jim Chester led Thiel offensively in the pair of wins, going 3-for-5 with a homerun and four RBI's ... Sophomore Mark McElravy improved to 4-2 after allowing just two runs on five hits in seven innings of work in the first game.

Westminster Titans

The Titans went 2-2 against PAC competition last week, falling 7-6 at Grove City before taking 2-of-3 against W&J ... The Titans swept the Presidents 5-0 and 14-3 on Saturday, before falling 9-8 in Washington on Sunday ... Senior SS B.G. Davison went 4-for-5 with an RBI in the Grove City loss ... In the W&J opener, senior Kevin Culp fired a three-hit shutout with nine strikeouts, while senior 3B Kevin Humberston and junior 2B Brian Goettler both homered ... Game two saw senior Matt Pournaras improve to 4-0 with the pitching win, while Davison was4for-4 at the plate with a pair of two-run home runs ... The Titans led 7-2 on Sunday, but gave up three runs in the bottom of the ninth to fall ... Culp was 3-for-5 with two runs scored.
