ERIC HOLT

Waynesburg College 6-2 Sophomore Outfielder/Pitcher Washington, Pa./Trinity H.S.

Holt led the Yellow Jackets to a 4-2 week. He threw a fiveinning one-hitter in a 10-0 shutout of Pitt-Greensburg, while also batting .421 (8-of-19) for the week with one home run, five runs scored and six RBIs.

Also nominated was senior shortstop/third baseman **Max Schimmel** of Bethany, junior catcher **Matt Skipper** of Grove City, and freshman shortstop **Jason Cramer** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped five of six last week and lost their starting centerfielder for the rest of the season in the process ... Scott Johnson was hit by a pitch in the second Waynesburg game Wednesday and suffered a broken left hand ... He will be out for the rest of the season ... In the first game of that day. Todd Welsh tossed a complete game five-hitter in a 4-1 victory ... Max Schimmel went 3-3 in the game with two runs scored and an RBI, while Welsh held down Waynesburg while recording two strikeouts ... For the week, Schimmel batted .471 (8-17) with five runs scored, three doubles and two RBIs.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped all three contests last week, falling to Marietta on Thursday and losing a doubleheader at Hiram on Thursday ... In the loss to 7th-ranked Marietta, the Presidents jumped out to an early 3-0 lead, but seven Marietta pitchers combined to allow just two hits over the next eight innings to defeat W&J, 12-3 ... Freshman C Frank Pilato led W&J with a 2-for-4 effort with one RBI ... Hiram scored the gamewinning run with a one-out single in the bottom of the seventh to top the Presidents, 5-4 ... W&J trailed 4-1 after five, but rallied to tie the game with a three-run homer by freshman SS Jason Cramer in the sixth ... Hiram scored four in the second and seven more in the sixth in the 13-3 win ... Pilato and freshman C Jared Kreider each went 1-for-3 with one RBI.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines collected a total of 31 hits en route to a DH sweep over visiting Bethany by finals of 13-2 and 20-4 ... In the opener, Grove City pounded out 16 hits ... DH Joel Diller belted a three-run homer as part of the Wolverines' five-run fifth inning ... 2B Jake Cuthbert went 4-for-5 with two runs scored ... RHP Mike Gundy permitted just five hits in seven innings and fanned nine to record the win ... Grove City jumped out to a 5-0 lead in the first inning of the nightcap as 1B Drew Hoagland cracked a three-run homer. ... In the second, Diller hit a two-run homer while 3B John Mycyk followed with a three-run blast ... LF Mike Volchko capped the scoring with a three-run homer in the sixth ... RHP Matt Kearney got the win.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets begin Tuesday an important stretch of six PAC conference games against the Washington & Jefferson Presidents and the Thiel Tomcats, as they look to improve upon their 5-1 conference record ... Sophomore pitcher Eric Holt pitched a five-inning one-hitter in the Jackets 10-0 victory Sunday over the Pitt-Greensburg Bobcats ... In addition to his pitching, Holt, who plays left field for the Jackets, hit .421 for the week.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats suffered a loss in their only action last week, falling 21-4 to Penn State-Behrend ... Freshman center fielder **Pat Aretz** went 2-for-2 with a three RBI double in the defeat ... Freshman pitcher **Shawn Ridgway** worked just 2 1/3 innings, but gave up 11 runs and issued eight walks in relief for starter **Mark McElravy** ...
