**Milton Joyner** ... After **Dan Smith** pitched 3 1/3 innings of scoreless relief, **Bobby Burger** picked up the win after throwing 2 1/3 shutout innings ... Game two saw Bethany pound out 17 runs, including nine in the 1<sup>st</sup>, on 17 hits ... C **Brent Owens** went 5-for-5 with a homer, two doubles, three runs and four RBIs, while four other Bison had multi-hit games ... **Brett Bartholomew** had two scoreless innings of relief for the win.



#### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City went 0-4 last week, including a PAC sweep at the hands of Thomas More ... GCC surrendered a dozen unearned runs last week as the Wolverines fielded just .903 ... Sophomore SS **Ben Wilson** went 3-for-3 in

the second game against TMC Friday ... He hit .462 (6-for-13) during the week ... Senior P **Justin Miller** made his first start of the season (second career) in Friday's nightcap against Thomas More ... Miller is Grove City's all-time saves leader (12) ... Saturday, freshman P **Jeff Baluch** allowed three earned runs in 7 1/3 innings with six strikeouts ... Freshman **Mike Herringshaw** made three relief appearances ... Thursday, GCC will play Lake Erie in Eastlake, Ohio at Classic Park, home of the Class A Lake County Captains.



#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats took two of three games from Westminster last week and climbed into third place in the PAC ... Thiel split in non-conference action last week, defeating Franciscan University 8-2 but falling to La Roche 7-5 ... Junior P Eric Wadowsky improved to 4-2 with the

Tomcats' 6-3 win over the Titans ... He allowed three runs on nine hits in the complete game ... Sophomore C **Andrew Howard** batted .450 last week with 5 runs scored ... He leads the team with a .370 batting average and is riding a nine-game hitting steak.



#### Thomas More Saints

Thomas More ran its win streak to eight games with a three-game PAC series sweep of Grove City ... The

sweep gave the Saints 10 PAC wins – eclipsing last season's total ... TMC connected on six home runs in the GCC series ... Senior **Dan Buchwald** led the Saints, hitting .571 for the week with one triple, one homer and eight RBI ... Junior **Pat Berndsen** was effective on the mound and at the plate against the Wolverines ... The right-hander allowed two earned runs in seven innings with four strikeouts in TMC's 9-3 win ... In addition, he hit .636 with a double, two home runs and seven RBI ... The starting staff yielded just seven earned runs in 17 innings of work ... Sophomore **Bryan Farrell** earned his first career save.

No. 28 W&J compiled a 5-1 record this week to up its record to 17-5 ... The Presidents swept a doubleheader Monday behind the pitching of senior **Sam Mann** and sophomore **Ian Poole** ... Poole tossed a three-hit shutout, while Mann allowed one unearned run in the complete game ... Senior 2B **Chris Varacallo** led the lineup with

two hits ... Senior **John Astfalk** allowed one unearned run on four hits during W&J's 11-1 win over Behrend ... Junior CF **Justin Benson** collected three hits and scored three times, while senior 3B **Shaun Pfeil** added two hits and two RBI ... Mann fired a five-hit complete game Friday to give W&J a 3-1 win over Waynesburg ... Varacallo had two hits and drove in one run ... Poole picked up his second win of the week Saturday ... Mann had four hits and four RBI.



# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets swept their doubleheader with Penn State-Altoona on Tuesday before taking one of three against conference-leading Washington & Jefferson ... Against the Lions, 3B **Dan Novak** posted a

4-for-6 performance with two doubles, two runs scored and five RBI, while 2B **Ryan Group** drove in three runs with a bases-loaded double ... Freshman **Zac Rhoades** and senior **Adam Sattler** registered the victories against the Lions ... In the weekend series against W&J, seniors **Chad Litten** and **Jon Conn** each collected a pair of RBIs ... Freshman **Ryan Lavrusky** earned a 4-2 complete-game victory against the Presidents, scattering five hits over seven innings with three strikeouts.



#### Westminster Titans

Westminster compiled a 1-4 record in five PAC games last week ... The Titans lost both games of a double-header at W&J Monday before dropping two out of three in a weekend series against Thiel ... The Titans were out-hit 52-33 during the week (.364-.243) and their pitchers amassed a 6.09 ERA compared to the opposition's 2.25 ERA ... Sophomore **John Izzo** led the team batting .429 (6-for-14) with two doubles and an RBI, including two hits in the 6-2 win over Thiel ... Also in the win, sophomore **Mike Busin** went 2-for-3 with

three runs scored, including a solo home run in the third inning that gave the Titans a 3-0 lead ... Junior SP **Jake Zatchok** earned the win, going 6 1/3 innings with two runs on seven hits, two walks and no strikeouts ... Freshman **Dave Evans** registered the save.



#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat diamondmen dropped all three contests lats weekend, falling 13-11 at incoming PAC member Geneva before dropping a doubleheader at home vs. league rival Bethany by scores of 6-5 and 17-6 ... Mike Killian leads the team with a .351 average, while Dave
