Pellis led the Presidents to a 5-0 week, in cluding a threegame PAC sweep of Thiel, by hitting .591 (13-for-22) with six runs scored and six RBIs. He extended his streak of multi-hit games to 10 before having it snapped in the final Thiel game.

Mann was 1-0 with a save on the hill last week for W&J. He pitched a scoreless ninth with two K's to preserve a 2-1 win over Frostburg State, then allowed two runs on eight hits with five strikeouts in eight innings on a 10-2 PAC win over Thiel.

Dan Berty ... In the loss to TMC, C **Justin Waychoff** started a big weekend at the plate with a solo homer ... Bethany's 3-2, nineinning victory over the Saints in game 1 Saturday featured a complete game by P **Adam Martin**, who allowed two runs on six hits ... Waychoff doubled in the sixth to tie the game, then scored the winning run on a Majewski single with two outs in the ninth ... In the nightcap, a two-run homer by LF **Aaron Meadows** and a solo blast by DH **Milton Joyner** helped give BC a 5-1 lead.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped a three-game series with W&J last week ... The Tomcats fell in the single game in Washington 10-2 Friday before losing 17-6 and 9-4 in the doubleheader in Greenville Saturday ... Senior 3B **Bob Flukas** finished 2-for-4 with a solo home run while freshman LF

Ryan Oldfield went 2-for-3 with a double on Friday ... In game one of the doubleheader, the Presidents, leading 7-6 through six innings, plated 10 runs in the top of the seventh inning to claim the 17-6 win ... Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents extended their win streak to seven games with a perfect 5-0 week ... W&J, which has won 11 of its past 12 contests, totaled 36 runs in a three-game sweep of Thiel this past weekend ... Sophomore CF **Matt Pellis** racked up two or more hits four times this week to extend his multi-hit streak to 10 games before he went 1-

for-4 in the second game of the Thiel doubleheader ... Junior 3B Shaun Pfeil drove in 12 runs during the week to bring his season total to 24 ... Junior John Astfalk and freshman **Ian Poole** were the winning pitchers in the doubleheader at Thiel, both improving to 5-0 ... Freshman **Dan Vietmeier** threw seven shutout innings and allowed only three hits in the 2-1 victory at Frostburg State ... Senior **Dan Yokitis** tossed six strong innings for the win over John Carroll.



Westminster Titans

Westminster posted win in all three of its non-league games last week, sweeping a home doubleheader with Mount Aloysius (5-3 and 6-2) Thursday before blasting seven home runs in a 14-11 road win at Lake Erie Friday ... Senior **Brenton Gilmore** and sophomore **Andy Robison** each posted complete game wins over the Mounties ... Sophomore OF **Don Womeldorff** and freshman OF **John Izzo** each hit homers in game one ... Game two saw the Titans break a 2-2 tie with a four-run sixth, keyed by a two-run double by sophomore 2B

Don Kirkwood ... Izzo homered twice with three RBIs and scored three times in the Lake Erie win ... Senior **Jason Mackey** earned the pitching win in relief against the Storm.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 3-1 last week, including a pair of wild home wins ... Sophomore 3B **Bryan Pierrot** drove in a career-high six runs in a 16-12 victory over La Roche Tuesday ... Freshman RP **Matt Tindall** induced a game-

ending double play to earn his first collegiate save ... Wednesday, Grove City rallied against Waynesburg with a three-run ninth that sent the game to extra innings ... Freshman 2B **Ben Wilson** tied the game in the ninth with a three-run double while Pierrot singled in Wilson with the game-winner in the 11th ... RP **Justin Miller** earned the win ... At Waynesburg Thursday, Grove City moved to 8-4 in the PAC by splitting a pair ... In an 11-2 nightcap win, junior LF **Chris Schwamberger** went 3-for-5 with two doubles and five RBI.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More started the week by setting the record for the most runs in consecutive games (36) ... The Saints

ran its streak to consecutive double-figure scoring games to three after kicking off its three-game series at Bethany with a 13-6 win. However, the Saints fell in both ends of the doubleheader against the Bison to lose their third straight PAC series ... Junior **Dustin Brown** went 11-for-22 with four RBI and three stolen bases, while junior **Fred Reiss** was 8-for-16 with one double, two homers and six RBI ... Junior **Marc Price** drove in a career-high five runs in the Saints' win over Wittenberg and finished the week 11-for-23 (.478) with two doubles, one triple, one home run and nine RBI ... Senior **Brad Thoma** had 10 RBI while hitting .429 (9-for-21).



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened the week with two losses from Geneva before an extra-inning loss to Grove City Wednesday ... The Yellow Jackets then split Thursday's doubleheader with the Wolverines, winning the first game 5-4 and losing the nightcap, 11-2 ... In the first Geneva game, WC rallied to tie the game 3-3 in the top of the seventh be-

fore the Golden Tornadoes added a run of their own in the seventh to win 4-3 ... Wednesday, the Jackets took a 4-1 lead in the ninth on a RBI single from CF **Brendon Steele** before the Wolverines tied the game in the bottom of the frame ... Waynesburg jumped out to a 5-1 lead through five innings of the first game of Thursday's twinbill before holding off a Grove City comeback to win 5-4 ... Four errors in game two against GCC led to six unearned runs ... C **Phil Anderson** belted his first home of the season in the loss.
