HALFWAY POINT: All nine PAC teams have now played at least half of their 24 conference games with three weeks to play ... W&J used a three-game sweep of Waynesburg to move into a first-place tie with Westminster, which took 2-of-3 at home vs. defending PAC champion Thomas More ... The PAC co-leaders meet for a three-game series this weekend.

NEWS & NOTES: Senior 1B **Andrew Thole** hit .556 (10-for-18) with three doubles for 3-2 Thomas More ... Senior P **Jeremy Mains** earned both wins in relief as Saint Vincent took a series win from Thiel ... Junior 1B **Kyle Shock** hit .500 (4-for-8) with five RBIs for 1-2 Grove City ... Senior P **Rob Baumgartel** fired a four-hit gem in a 1-0 Waynesburg win over Kenyon.

AROUND THE PAC: Senior C **Adam Scheiderer** batted .500 (5-for-10) with three RBIs as Geneva took 2-of-3 from Grove City ... Thiel P **Brad Bates** tied his season-high with six strikeouts in an 8-3 win at Saint Vincent ... **Brad Kubis** of Bethany was 3-for-7 at the plate and earned a save on the hill in a DH split at Case Western Reserve Saturday.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (9-15, 5-10 PAC)



The Bison were slated to have a busy week of non-conference games, but due to rain, Bethany managed to only get in two games at Case Western Saturday ... In game one, BC cut a 4-0 deficit to 4-3 thanks to a two-run double from **Brad Kubis** and **Dan Weller** stealing home as part of a double steal, but Case scored three times in the fifth and went on to a 7-4 win ... In the second game, **Tyler Kurtz** threw four shutout innings, which allowed Bethany to build a 5-0 lead ... When Case got within 5-2, Kubis relieved and threw 2 1/3 scoreless innings for his third save of the year and 20th of his career ... He also went 2-for-3 at the plate with an RBI and two runs scored, while SS **Juls Leto** was 2-for-4 with an RBI and one run scored.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-16, 8-10 PAC)



Geneva's baseball team saw its offense spark up on Friday in an 11-6 victory over Grove City ... **Adam Scheiderer** was 3-4 in leading the nine-hit attack against the Wolverines ... **Mike Jeffreys** came on in relief to earn his fifth victory of the season ... Jeffreys won his sixth game of the year in Saturday's night cap as Geneva held on for a 8-5 victory in game two after dropping game one 10-3 ... The doubleheader split with Grove City left Geneva's overall record at 14-16 and 8-10 in the conference ... Geneva is just one game out of the win column for the fourth and final PAC play-off spot with still six games remaining ... The Golden Tornadoes head to Kentucky this weekend for a three-game series against Thomas More.

Grove City Wolverines (5-19, 3-9 PAC)



Grove City went 1-2 in a week-end series with Geneva Friday and Saturday ... In a 10-3 Wolverine win Saturday, junior **Zach Struharik** went 3 for 4 with a double while junior **Kyle Shock** went 2 for 3 with a double ... **Max Vickerman** pitched six innings to earn the win ... Shock also doubled in game two of Saturday's doubleheader with Geneva ... **Tom Hawley** doubled and singled ... Freshmen **Chris Curran**, **Lee Coppock** and **C.J. Fitzgerald** each pitched a scoreless inning of relief ... Friday, Shock homered at Geneva ... Hawley tripled and then made his first collegiate pitching appearance in the eighth inning ... Senior **Brandon Durbin** went 2-for-4 ... Freshmen have pitched 53 percent (87 of 164) of Grove City's innings this year ... Grove City visits Waynesburg Tuesday before squaring off with Thiel this weekend.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-10, 8-7 PAC)



The Bearcats took the season series from Thiel after starting the week with a non-conference loss to La Roche ... In the first game of the double-dip against the Tomcats, SVC rallied from a 7-4 deficit to post a walk-off 8-7 win ... SVC was down to its final strike twice in the bottom of the seventh, but senior **Jack Shaffer** delivered the game-tying RBI single and junior **Grant Krally** scored on a throwing error to win ... Both Shaffer and junior **Andrew Kozusko**, who started the rally with a single, battled with two strikes and the Bearcats with one out left ... Senior **Jeremy Mains** picked up the win out of the bullpen in both Bearcat victories this week to run his record to 4-2 ... In the second game of Friday's doubleheader, junior **Jared Haller** suffered his first loss of the season to fall to 6-1 on the year.

Thiel Tomcats (12-16, 5-7 PAC)



The Tomcats split Saturday's doubleheader at Saint Vincent before suffering a 6-5 10-inning setback against Bearcats Sunday in Greenville ... In game one, the Bearcats rallied with four runs in the bottom of the seventh to secure an 8-7 victory, but the Tomcats bounced back with an 8-3 come-from-behind win in game two to preserve the split ... **Brad Bates** tied his season-high with six strikeouts in the game two complete-game win, allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits ... **Doug Farley** finished 3-for-5 with a season-high three RBIs and two runs scored, while **Eric King** and **Phil Double** each added a pair of hits ... A one-out bases-loaded walk in the top of the 10th for the Bearcats ended their 6-5 win at Tomcat Park Sunday ... **Ryan Dixon** collected his second three-hit game of the season for TC.

Thomas More Saints (18-10, 8-7 PAC)



Thomas More went 3-2 last week, including a 1-2 mark against PAC foe Westminster ... Thomas More had two players bat over .400 as senior 1B **Andrew Thole** batted .556 with three doubles, three RBIs and four runs scored and sophomore SS **David Kennett** batted .435 with two doubles, five RBI and six runs scored ... On the mound last week, the Saints were led by sophomore **Andy Roenker** with a 1.12 ERA as he pitched eight innings and gave up two runs (one earned) on night hits and struck out four, while posting a 1-0 record ... For the season, Kennett leads the team at the plate as he has a .410 batting average with nine doubles, three triples, 19 RBI and 33 runs scored ... The Saints are led on the mound this season by **David Etscheid**, who has a 2.50 ERA, a 3-1 record and three saves.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (19-4, 10-2 PAC)



W&J produced a 3-1 week that included a sweep of PAC rival Waynesburg ... The Presidents have now won nine straight against the Yellow Jackets ... Senior **Dave Trushel** tossed his team-leading fifth complete game and earned his sixth win of the season while striking out a season-high 10 batters Friday ... Trushel now has 22 career victories, the second-highest total in school history ... W&J plated five runs despite producing just two hits in game two against Waynesburg on Saturday ... Sophomore RHP **Randy Risch** tossed five shutout innings to earn the victory in game two against the Yellow Jackets ... Sophomore C **Ronnie Peirish** led W&J at the plate with four runs, three RBIs and his second-career home run in four games last week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (16-13, 6-9 PAC)



The week started well for Waynesburg, but ended with a thud as the Yellow Jackets lost their final four games, including a three-game sweep at the hands of W&J ... Senior **Rob Baumgartel** led the Jackets to their only win in five games by pitching a four-hit complete game gem against Kenyon ... Of those four hits, three were singles and he didn't walk a Lord batter ... Junior RF **Adam Horning** smacked a walk-off single in the bottom of the seventh for a 1-0 win ... Unfortunately, that was the last win of the week for the Jackets, whose usually potent bats managed just nine runs in five games ... Waynesburg had a chance for a crucial conference win in the opener of Saturday's doubleheader with the Presidents, but W&J posted two runs in the top of the eighth inning to grab a 5-3 win.

Westminster Titans (19-9, 10-2 PAC)



After sweeping Thomas More in a doubleheader Saturday, the Titans fell short 10-9 to the Saints Sunday in extra innings ... Westminster had its most productive inning in the fifth as they capitalized on two Saint errors and scored five runs in total to take an 8-2 lead ... Juniors **Kyle Allen** and **Chris Ross** each had an RBI in the inning ... Thomas More, however, rallied to score two runs in the sixth and five in the seventh to take a 9-8 lead ... Down 9-8 in the ninth, senior **Steve Perrotta** led off with a double and would later score after TMC's leftfielder bobbled the ball ... The Saints did not waste any time to score in extras as they would score in the 10th to take a 10-9 lead ... The Titans had an opportunity with runners on the corners with two outs in their final at bat, but were unable to score any runs.
