Sinclair earned his first collegiate victory when he tossed a nine-inning, complete game 3-0 shutout of PAC rival Washington & Jefferson Friday. He scattered six hits while issuing no walks and striking out six batters.

#### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany notched consecutive losses (14-9 to Seton Hill; 10-8 to Gr ove City) before posting back-to-back conference wins (5-4, 11-8 over Grove City) to end their roller-coaster week ... The Bison enjoyed a good week at the plate, raising their team average to a respectable .307 in their 27 contests ... lan Edwards notched a milestone with his save against Grove City Saturday in the first game of a double-header ... Edwards' sixth save of the season moved him up to 10 in a career, setting both the season-total and career-total marks for a Bison pitcher ... Leadoff hitter Rich Majewski has notched 11 runs in his last 10 contests, scoring in all but one of those games.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents pulled out five victories in six contests this past week to improve to 16-8 overall ... On Thursday, W&J knocked off Frostburg State, who was ranked eighth in the ABCA Mid-Atlantic Regional Poll ... Sophomore 3B Shaun Pfeil raised his season average to .470 with four hits ... He had two singles, a double and a triple, while also scoring three times ... Sophomores RF Ron Mitko and 1B Sam Mann were both 3for-4 with two RBI, while freshman P Ryan Jaczesko earned his first collegiate victory ... Sophomore pitchers Mike Trumpower and John Astfalk hurled complete games vs. Waynesburg Saturday ... Freshman CF Justin Benson led a sweep of Juniata by going 4-for-5, including a grand slam, with seven RBI.

Grove City earned its first PAC win of 2005 Friday against Bethany ... Joel Diller's two-run double in the bottom of the eighth put Grove City up for good ... Reliever Mike Kennedy earned his first win of the year while sophomore Justin Miller notched his first career save ... Michael McMillen went 4-for-4 with three runs scored in the victory ... Kennedy earned the save Tuesday at Pitt-Greensburg as Grove City snapped an eight-game slide ... Freshman Ryan Jones went 7-for-8 in the doubleheader at UP-G while Jonathan Mycyk belted his first homer of the year ... Luke Lester got the win after pitching into the seventh ... Freshman 2B Bryan Pierrot cracked three hits against La Roche.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg started the week with backto-back wins over St. Vincent, 13-11, and W&J, 3-0, before dropping a pair to the Presidents Saturday, 5-3 and 10-1 ... The Jackets overcame a four-run lead in the eighth Tuesday against Saint Vincent to record the 13-11victory ... SS Ryan Group and OFs Jim Morris and Brendon Steele each finished with threehit games, while 1B Chad Litten joined Group, Morris and Steele in posting a pair of RBI each ... Sophomore P Landon Sinclair tossed a complete game win over the Presidents to earn his first collegiate victory, scattering six hits and recorded six strikeouts with yielding a walk ... Junior 2B Brian Gerginski hit his third home run of the season, while senior C/ OF Joe Vincent collected three hits.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 1-5 overall and 0-3 in PAC meetings ... Junior CF Brett Bell and freshman LF Parke Bongiorno each went 3-for-5 in the Tomcats' 14-4 win at La Roche while junior C Kinsey Henderson posted three RBIs ... Bell put Thiel in front of Westminster 4-3 in game one with his RBI single in the sixth before the Titans responded with four in the bottom of the frame ... Junior 3B Bob Flukas finished 2-for-3 from the plate with a pair of RBIs ... In the 12-3 game two defeat, Flukas finished 2-for-4 with two runs scored, a home run and an RBI ... Sophomore SS Ben Cobler went 2-for-5 with two RBIs in the Sunday loss, while senior 2B Jon Spencer was 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a weekend threegame sweep of Thiel to take sole possession of first place in the PAC at 7-2 ... Earlier in the week, the Titans fell at Penn State-Behrend (9-7) before sweeping a home pair with Case Western Reserve (6-2, 16-2) ... Junior OF/3B Ed DeRose posted at least one hit in all six games and hit .524 (11-of-21) for the week ... Senior OF Brooks LeViere was 2-for-2 with a home run, a triple and three RBIs in the CWRU nightcap, while junior 3B Mark Francazio was 2-for-2 with a home run, a double, two runs scored and three RBIs ...
