Goist batted .594 (19-of-32) for the week with six doubles, nine runs scored and 17 RBIs as the Tomcats posted a 5-3 record. He currently leads Thiel in hitting (.408), hits (51), doubles (14) and RBIs (35).

Mann tossed nine shutout innings for Washington & Jefferson in a 2-0 blanking of PAC rival Waynesburg on Thursday, allowing just six hits and one walk while striking out six. He increased his current scoreless innings streak to 21.

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 2-3 last week against West Liberty and Thiel ... The two Bison wins came on Saturday in a doubleheader at home against Thiel by scores of 9-5 and 13-4 ... The Tomcats then avenged those losses with a 8-5 triumph at home Sunday ... For the week, C Justin Waychoff and D.J. Hynes led the way by both hitting .500 ... Waychoff was 7for-14 for the week with twu runs and two RBI, while Hynes went 5-for-10 with three runs, a double, a home run and three RBI ... In game one against Thiel, Hynes went 2-for-4 with a home run, two runs and two RBI ... lan Dunn hit for a .455 (5-for-11) clip for the week, with four runs and two RBI ... Rich Majewski drove in six runs and scored three in game two.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up three PAC victories last week, starting with a 2-0 victory over Waynesburg on Thursday at Ross Memorial Park ... Freshman P/1B Sam Mann outdueled the Yellow Jackets' Eric Holt by hurling a complete-game sevenhitter ... Mann has now thrown 21 consecutive scoreless innings ... He also scored the game-winning run after freshman 2B Chris Varacallo's double ... Sophomore P Ross Kelchner and freshman P Mike Trumpower combined for 17 strikeouts in the sweep of Westminster on Saturday ... Kelchner allowed four hits and three walks, while fanning nine in the first game ... Trumpower did not allow a hit until the fifth inning and struck out eight ... Freshman LF Brett Glass had two hits and three RBI in game two.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City edged above .500 in the PAC last week by winning three of five league games, including a home sweep of Westminster Wednesday ... The Wolverines racked up a season-high 21 hits in the opener as all nine starters had at least one hit ... Greg Hrebinko went 4-for-4 with four RBIs while Mike Ritter and A.J. Stedford both had three-hit days ... Ritter hit .588 (10-for-17) during the week ... Sophomore Ryan Carr fired six shutout innings against the Titans, allowing just one hit ... Sean O'Donnell picked up the win in the second game while Erik Arnesen earned the save ... Arnesen pitched seven innings of relief to earn the win Saturday at Waynesburg, fanning a dozen Waynesburg batters.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

A busy week for Waynesburg had the Jackets completing two 2-1 season series wins over Thiel and Grove City ... The Jackets defeated Thiel (5-4) on Monday, lost to W&J (2-0) on Wednesday, and went 2-1 in a weekend series with Grove City ... Four players batted over .500 for the five games (3-2), led by Matt Cross' team-high average of .526 ... Cross' biggest hit of the week came against Thiel with a two-run double that sent the game to extra innings ... Senior Eric Holt batted .524 for the week going 11-for-21, including a perfect 9-for-9 in the two wins over Grove City ... Holt's 12th home run of his career and first of the season added three insurance runs in the Jackets' 7-3 win over Grove City ... Holt also pitched for a save during the game.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 5-3 last week but dropped all three conference contests, falling to 4-8 in the PAC ... Thiel avenged a DH sweep at Bethany on Saturday by posting an 8-5 victory over the Bison Sunday at Packard Park ... Junior P Keith Jackson evened his season record at 4-4 with the win, allowing four runs (3 earned) on eight hits in 7.2 innings of work ... Senior P Jarred Floch picked up his first save as a Tomcat, working the final 1.1 innings ... Thiel went up 3-1 in the third on RBI singles from junior 2B Jon Keenan, senior SS Caleb Goist and sophomore 1B Bob Flukas ... The Tomcats added single runs in the fourth and sixth before tallying three in the seventh, keyed by Spencer's two-run single.

Westminster Titans

The Titans went 1-4 in PAC play last week, dropping road doubleheaders at Grove City (14-0 and 5-3) and W&J (4-0, 5-3) before topping the Presidents 11-4 at home ... Sophomore Brenton Gilmore earned the pitching win against W&J, allowing three runs (two earned) with seven walks and five strikeouts in seven innings of work ... Offensively the Titans pounded out 16 hits, with senior 2B Brian Goettler leading the way by going 3-for-5 with a run scored, two steals and two RBIs ... Senior C Ben Yeckel was a perfect 3-for-3 at the plate with a double and an RBI in the second Grove City game ... Goettler went 2-for-3 with a double and two RBIs in the Saturday nightcap loss to the Presidents.
