## Bethany Bison (16-11, 4-8 PAC)



Bethany posted a 5-2 record last week, which included sweeps of Pitt-Greensburg and Franciscan and handing Thomas More its first PAC loss ... 3B **Brad Kubis** went 7-for-10 with 6 RBIs in the UPG twinbill and earned a save in the nightcap ... Against Franciscan, BC scored 14 runs in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning to rally for a 19-16 game 2 win after taking the opener 11-3 ... 2B **Eric Fudala** went 6-for-8 in the games with 3 RBIs and 3 runs scored ... RF **Chris Leasure** had a monster day against Thomas More in Saturday's DH, going 5-for-5 with 4 HRs and 7 RBIs ... He hit a 3-run blast and solo shot in the Bison's 11-7 win in game 2 and tied the Bethany single-season HR record with 9 ... For the week, he hit 6 homers and drove in 14, while Kubis batted .516 with 14 RBIs.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (10-17)



Geneva finally saw its offense come alive in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader with Grove City. After falling 5-1 in game one for their third straight loss of the week, the Golden Tornadoes exploded for 11 first inning runs en route to a 17-6 victory over the Wolverines. **Phil Shallenberger** led the charge with four of Geneva's 17 hits in the contest. A total of six Geneva starters finished the game with multiple hits with seven players coming up with at least one RBI. **Matt Baer** won his second consecutive start on the mound and improved to 3-3 on the year. Geneva ended the week with an overall record of 10-17 as they welcome Grove City for a make-up game on Monday before games with Westminster and Waynesburg later in the week.

## Grove City Wolverines (12-10, 5-1 PAC)



Grove City went 2-2 last week, including a 2-1 mark at home ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 19-4 win over Westminster ... **Andrew Patterson** went 4 for 4 with a homer and two doubles ... **Butch Kriger** went 5 for 6 ... **Mike Herringshaw** worked six innings for the win ... Tuesday, the Wolverines dropped an 8-7 decision at Allegheny in 12 innings ... The Wolverines had not gone 12 innings in a game since 2006 ... Saturday, Grove City split a doubleheader with Geneva ... Herringshaw improved to 6-1 after throwing five shutout innings in the opener ... He has walked one batter in his last 21 innings ... Kriger cracked a two-run double in the first inning ... In Game Two, Grove City suffered its first home setback of the year ... Scott Moran went 3 for 4 ... header.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (14-11)



The Bearcats went 2-2 on the week, beating Geneva on Monday before taking just 1-of-3 set vs. Waynesburg. In Monday's 15-9 win over the GTs, SVC rapped 17 hits, with six players recording multi-hit games. **Jack Shaffer**, **Grant Krally**, and **Steve Bayko** all went 3-for-4, with Shaffer driving in four RBIs and Bayko three. **Danny Jackson** went 2-for-2 with three walks, three runs, and three stolen bases, before closing the game out with 1.2 scoreless innings of relief. In the WU opener, an 11-8 win, Krally hit a three-run homer, while Shaffer and **Adam Miller** each had three hits and two RBIs. The Jackets then won the final two of the set. In game two Saturday, **Paul Kubeja** was saddled with a tough no-decision, going eight innings and allowing three runs on four hits with four strikeouts.

## Thiel Tomcats (11-13, 4-8 PAC)



Thiel dropped four games last week, starting with a 17-11 loss to Penn State-Behrend and ending with a weekend series sweep at the hands of Wash. & Jeff. The Tomcats had four player bat over .400 last week, led by OF **Phil Double** who hit at a blistering .538 clip (7-for-13). He and CF **Luke Johnson** each notched a team-high five RBI. Johnson hit .526 (10-for-19) on the week, with a team-high four runs scored. C **Brook Porter** belted his first homerun of the season on Saturday against W&J. Thiel plays five games next week including a road doubleheader at Grove City on Tuesday and its last three non-conference games of the season. The Tomcats welcome Allegheny at 3 p.m. on Wednesday. Case Western Reserve pays a visit to Tomcat Park on Saturday for a 1 p.m. doubleheader.

## Thomas More Saints (17-10, 5-1 PAC)



The Saints went 3-1 last week, including a 2-1 mark in the PAC as it defeated Transylvania and then won two of three at Bethany ... At the plate last week the Saints were led by freshman SS **David Kennett**, who batted .667 as he was 10-for-15 with a double, five runs batted-in and five runs scored ... Sophomore P **Paul Uhl** had a 2.57 earned run average last week as he pitched seven inning giving up two runs (both earned) on six hits and striking out two ... For the season, the Saints are led offensively by junior LF **Max Robbins**, who is batting .477 as he is 42-for-88 with 13 doubles, 33 RBI and 29 runs scored ... Uhl leads the Saints' pitching staff as he has a 1.40 ERA with a 7-1 record as he has pitched 45 innings giving up 14 runs (seven earned) on 27 hits and striking out 39.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (19-5, 9-0 PAC)



The Wash. & Jeff. baseball team extended its school-record win streak to 12 games last week after defeating La Roche (7-4), and sweeping its third-straight PAC series of the season against Thiel ... In addition, the Presidents also upped their regular-season home win streak to 20 games ... Eighth-year head coach **Jeff Mountain** reached a career milestone Saturday afternoon as he captured his 200<sup>th</sup> career victory ... Mountain's career record now stands at 202-119-1 (.627), including a 175-76-1 (.694) mark since 2005 ... Junior CF **Andy Trettel** also kept his current on-base streak alive last weekend and has now reached base safely in 56 consecutive games and is just four games shy of tying the NCAA Division III record set by Salve Regina's Damian Constantino (Apr. 4, 2001 - Mar. 10, 2003).

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (11-15, 5-7 PAC)



After dropping the first game of a three-game weekend series with Saint Vincent, the Waynesburg baseball team rebounded to take two from the Bearcats. In game two of a seven-inning twin bill in Latrobe, senior 2B **Wes White, Jr.** drove in the eventual game-winning run in the top of the ninth with an RBI single. Despite cold, dreary conditions this past Sunday, the Yellow Jacket bats stayed hot over nine innings of a 7-3 win. White homered and scored three runs, while junior CF **Rob Cool, Jr.** went a perfect four-for-four and drove in three runs. Freshman P **Anthony Longo** improved to 3-1 on the year after working 8.1 innings in his fourth start of the year.

## Westminster Titans (8-18, 4-8 PAC)



The Titans had their season-long seven-game losing streak extended at Grove City Monday with a 19-4 PAC loss before snapping that skid with a 14-5 home win over Geneva on Wednesday. Westminster then lost both games of a non-conference doubleheader at Case Western Reserve on Saturday by scores of 4-2 and 10-3. Three Titans posted four or more hits during the week led by senior C **Dan Argiro** batting 5-for-15 with three doubles, followed by freshman OF **Tyler Robinson** at 4-for-10 with two doubles and senior OF **Dave Evans** at 4-for-12 with a double. No pitcher logged more than five innings for the entire week. Freshman **Andy Wallen** went five innings in his first career start before taking a no decision in the win over Geneva. Sophomore **Ethan Yeager** got the win by pitching two shutout innings.
