PAC BASEBALL 2009 - Week 7 Conference Notes

W&J IN FIRST PLACE: After posting a perfect 4-0 record last week, the Presidents find themselves at the top of the PAC standings. W&J posted a 6-1 victory over the second place Saints before the second game was suspended due to darkness after the 10th inning tied up at 3-3. The Saint and Presidents meet again on Wednesday in Washington to complete the suspended game before playing the third game of the series. Thiel has control of third place, while the fourth spot remains open.

WHO'S HOT: Bethany picked up its first two conference wins over Westminster behind **Tyler Dillinger** who batted .500 on the week for 2-2 Bison...Sophomore C **Marcus Magister** hit .368 with two doubles and a home run while slugging .632 for the 2-3 Wolverines...Freshman P **Jim Prejsnar** improved to 4-1 with his third complete game of the season for Westminster ... **Tadd Eyster** went 4-5 in the loss to Westminster for Geneva then went 3-3 with a pair of home runs in Geneva's win over Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: The Saints went 2-3 last week and dropped to second in the standings ... Sophomore DH **Spencer Franzreb** led the Saint in batting last week with a .412 average ... The Bearcats went 3-3 on the week ... **Chris Zampogna** went seven innings on the hill allowing just two hits in SVC's 18-0 romp over Hilbert on Sunday ... In the win the Bearcats pounded out 20 hits ... Thiel swept a non-conference doubleheader against Case Western Reserve to improve to 21-11 on the season.

After dropping a doubleheader to Saint Vincent, the Bison broke into the PAC win column by taking two of three from Westminster ... CF **Tyler Dillinger** went 3-for-5 and scored 2 runs, while DH **Chris Leasure** was 2-for-4 with a pair of RBIs in the 6-4 win in game 1 ... **T.J. Zarewicz** started and earned the win after throwing 4 1/3 innings, while **Scott Fraley** picked up the save ... RF **Mike Pegg** went 2-for-3 with a double and two RBIs in the 7-4 loss in the second game ... BC claimed the series by outslugging the Titans 14-13 Sunday in a game that featured 36 hits, including 20 by the Bison ... Dillinger went 4-for-5 with the game winning single in the 9th, while Leasure was 3-for-4 with a homer and LF Mark Cummins had 3 hits and scored 4 times

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (18-10)



Offense, offense, offense was the word for the week for the Geneva baseball team, both for and against. In four games this week, the Golden Tornadoes and their opponents combined for 99 runs. After dropping a 14-11 decision to Westminster early in the week, Geneva took two of three games from Waynesburg over the weekend. **Tadd Eyster** was 4-5 in the loss to Westminster and then put together a 3-3 day with a pair of home runs in Geneva's win over Waynesburg on Friday. It seemed like everyone got into the offensive groove on Saturday as Geneva put up 23 runs but came away with a split. **Derek Sumner** won his seventh game of the season with a complete game effort in game one. **Joe** and **Jon Jurinko** each launched home runs in the game two loss.

Grove City Wolverines (11-14, 4-6 PAC)



Grove City went 2-3 in conference play last week, earning wins at Thiel and Thomas More ... **Marcus Magister's** run-scoring double in the eighth inning Wednesday, helped give Grove City an 11-9 win at Thiel ... In the nightcap, **Mike Herringshaw** held Thiel to just two runs over six innings ... Herringshaw earned the win Saturday at Thomas More as the Wolverines pulled out a 6-4 win in Game One ... **Brad Stombaugh's** run-scoring double in the top of the seventh broke a 4-4 tie ... **Scott Moran** and Magister both homered in Saturday's nightcap at Thomas More ... Magister has seven home runs this year, which is the third-most in program history ... Nate Kauffman belted 12 homers in 2001 while Brian Moran had eight taters last year.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-26)



The Bearcats went 3-3 on the week. On Thursday, SVC swept a doubleheader at Bethany, winning 14-3 and 8-5. **Dustin Lousseddes** had a big day at the plate, going 4-6 in the twinbill with two home runs and seven RBIs. Mike Adams went 5-8 over two games, while Mike **Hustava** and **Chris Zampogna** each had four hits on the day, with Hustava hitting his first career homer in the nightcap and Zampogna driving in five RBIs in the opener. On Friday and Saturday, SVC was swept in a three-game set with W&J, before the Bearcats bounced back with an 18-0 home victory over Hilbert on Sunday. Zampogna worked seven innings on the hill and allowed just two hits while striking out six, while the Bearcats pounded 20 hits, including 10 for extra bases. **Rob Patula** went 3-4 with a double and two RBIs.

Thiel Tomcats (21-11, 11-6 PAC)



Thiel swept a non-conference doubleheader Saturday at Case Western Reserve to improve to 21-11 on the season, with finals of 3-1 and 8-0 ... In the day's first game, **James Teyssier** started the game and threw six strong innings, striking out three while giving up only two extra-base hits ... **Mark Brewer** pitched the seventh to earn his third save of the year ... In the second game of the twinbill, **Justin Fiorello** pitched a complete-game shutout while striking out seven and walking just one batter ... **Louie Parrilla** paced the Thiel offense, putting together a 3-for-4 day and scoring three runs ... **David Nypaver** scored a pair of runs while stroking a three-run homer in the third ... On Wednesday, Thiel posted a, 2-1, win over Grove city to secure a split in the midweek twinbill at Tomcat Park...

Thomas More Saints (22-7-1, 7-3 PAC)



The Saints went 2-3 last week as they dropped a game to W&J and Bluffton and won two-of-three against Grove City. Sophomore designated hitter **Spencer Franzreb** led the team in batting last week with a .412 average as he was seven-for-17 with a home run, two doubles, four runs batted-in and five runs scored ... Sophomore second baseman **Sam Schmeltzer** hit .375 as he was six-for-16 with two doubles and two RBI ... In the Saints' 12-3 win over Grove City, junior right fielder **Marty Kersting** hit a grand slam home run ... On the mound last week, freshman **Paul Uhl** led the Saints' pitching staff as he had a 2.57 earned run average as he gave up three runs (two earned) on four hits and struck out four in seven innings of work.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (19-8, 8-2 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson baseball team posted a 4-0 record last week, defeating Thomas More, 6-1, on Wednesday afternoon and sweeping a three-game series with Saint Vincent over the weekend ... The second game of the W&J-TMC doubleheader was suspended due to darkness after the 10th inning tied at 3-3 and will be resumed this Wednesday at Ross Memorial Park prior to the start of the originally scheduled nine-inning contest ... With the victory over the Saints, the Presidents currently sit at the top of the PAC baseball standings with an 8-2 mark in league play, while the Saints hold down the second place position with a record of 7-3.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (15-14, 6-5 PAC)



The Waynesburg baseball team is coming off of an up-and-down week that saw them start and end with road victories marked by huge offensive numbers. The Yellow Jackets opened the stretch with a 16-8 win over Pitt-Greensburg in a game that was held at Consol Energy Park in Washington. The Jackets were led by second baseman **Wes White, Jr.**, who scored four runs and reached base four times, and designated hitter **Bill Hanning** who chipped in a game-high four hits. Waynesburg out-hit the Bobcats 20-14 to pick up the win. After suffering a nine-inning loss at home to Geneva and dropping the front end of a doubleheader at the home of the Golden Tornadoes, the Jacket bats exploded for 20 runs on a season-high 22 hits.

Westminster Titans (13-19, 6-9 PAC)



The Westminster baseball team went 3-3 last week by beating Geneva, 14-11, on Wednesday, splitting a doubleheader against Hiram (13-10, 7-9) on Thursday and going 1-2 against Bethany over the weekend. The Titans split a home doubleheader vs. the Bison on Saturday, losing 6-4 before winning 7-4, and then lost at Bethany on Sunday, 14-13. Senior first baseman **John Izzo** batted .583 (14-24) with four doubles, two home runs and nine RBI, including 4-for-5 with a homer in the Titans' 14-11 win at Geneva.
