### PAC BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### **JAKE CUTHBERT**

Grove City College 5-9 Sophomore Second Baseman Belle Vernon, Pa./Belle Vernon H.S.

Cuthbert hit .643 last week (9-of-14) with a double, a triple and five RBIs and posted a slugging percentage of .857 to lead Grove City to a 3-1 week against PAC competition (2-1 vs. Thiel, 1-0 vs. Washington & Jefferson).

Also nominated was sophomore shortstop/pitcher **Caleb Goist** of Thiel, freshman catcher/second baseman **Frank Pilato** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior infielder **Brad Baker** of Waynesburg.

## **PAC BASEBALL NOTES**

## **Bethany Bison**

Bethany's woes continued this week with five losses as the Bison losing skid hit eight games ... In managing only six runs in the five games, the Bison bats were held to 21 hits ... In the OWU loss, catcher **Paul Krisanda** hit a two-run homer and 1B **Sean Flood** and 2B **Shaun Spencer** had RBI singles ... In the first Westminster game, RF **Matt Raiti** clubbed two doubles for the Bison's only hits and 3B **Brad Hicks** hit his first homer of the season for Bethany's only run in the nightcap.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J won one of four contests last week with the lone win coming at home over Waynesburg, 5-4, on a ninth-inning RBI single by sophomore LF Joel Yungen ... Junior P B.J. Swartzlander picked up his first collegiate victory by hurling two innings and allowing just one hit ... He also went 2-for-4 at the plate with two RBI, while junior RF Brent Rockwell added two hits and one run ... In the DH loss to the Yellow Jackets, senior 2B Justin Murphy picked up two hits and one RBI, while freshman C Frank Pilato went 2-for-6 with two RBI and three runs scored ... Yungen and Pilato were the only two Presidents to accumulate more than one hit against Grove City on Friday ... Swartzlander is currently batting .398 with nine doubles and 15 RBI.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

After a 1-10 start, the Wolverines have won five of their last six games ... Grove City batted .411 in a 3-1 week last week (60-146) and averaged 11.8 runs per game ... Sophomore 2B Jake Cuthbert went 9-for-14 with a double, triple and five RBI ... Freshman DH Joel Diller went 7-for-15 with a double and four RBI, freshman 3B John Mycyk went 6-for-13 with a double and sophomore OF Greg Grupp went 5-for-11 ... Junior C Matt Skipper extended his hitting streak to 12 games, going 7-for-16 last week ... Senior OF Mike Volchko, junior 1B Steve Navarro and freshman OF Michael McMillen each homered ... Grupp fanned 10 and scattered seven hits over eight innings against W&J.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Infielder Brad Baker (.529), catcher Bill Tenney (.444), infielder Anthony Bellotte (.428) and outfielder George Taylor (.421) led the Jackets offensive assault this week as the Jackets finished the PAC season with an 8-4 record ... Senior pitcher Nick Sivrich fired a three-hitter in the Jackets 2-1 victory over Thiel College on Saturday ... The Tomcats had defeated the Jackets 15-14 the day before.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 3-3 in PAC action last week, bringing their conference record to 8-4 ... The Tomcats took two out of three against Waynesburg last weekend, earning a15-14 victory on Friday before splitting the doubleheader on Saturday at Packard Park ... Junior 3B Randy Chiquelin hit his eighth and ninth homeruns of the season last week ... Chiquelin now has 21 career homers, more than doubling the next closest individual in career home runs as a Tomcat (B. Bilock (9) 98-01) ... The Tomcats have also surpassed the college's single season team record for homers (19 in 2001) this season, totaling 22 through April 20...the Tomcats will now prepare for the 2002 PAC tournament.

#### Westminster Titans

The Titans continued to roll last week, sweeping La Roche (4-3 and 7-1) on Tuesday and Bethany (19-0 and 11-1) on Saturday to stretch their win streak to a season-high seven games ... Sophomore P Pat Boyle went 2-0 on the week and is now 8-1 with a 1.05 ERA this season ... Junior P Kevin Culp also picked up a pair of pitching wins, improving to 4-3 with a 4.89 ERA ... The Titans blasted seven home runs in the two games against Bethany ... Sophomore SS Nathan Statzer has 17 stolen bases this season, just two shy of the school record held by Don Nogay (1992) ... Statzer and sophomore DH Tony Deane each posted a pair of home runs in the sweep of the Bison on Saturday.
