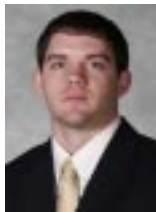

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 4-3 last week, which included a 14-4 win over Saint Vincent for head coach **Rick Carver's** 300th career victory ... **C Brent Owens** drove in six in the milestone victory ... The week also included a 13-3 loss to #30 and defending national champion Marietta ... Bethany dropped two of three to Waynesburg, with the win being a 2-1 victory, as **Aaron Brest** threw a complete game three-hitter ... BC closed the week by sweeping Pitt-Greensburg, as 3B **Chris Jeffers** had three hits and three RBIs and 1B **Ryan Simmons** also drove in three in the first game ... The nightcap saw **Justin McBee** scatter six hits over seven innings and come within one out of a shutout in a 6-1 triumph.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City dropped below the .500 mark on the season with an 0-4 week ... GCC received complete-game pitching efforts from freshman **Mike Herringshaw** and senior **Justin Miller** ... Herringshaw fired eight innings at Lake Erie Thursday, allowing three earned runs ... Miller fired a five-hitter in game one of Saturday's doubleheader at Westminster ... The Wolverines managed just six total hits in two games Saturday ... Junior **C Ray Mertz** belted a two-run double in the opener at Westminster ... Friday, Grove City fell behind 7-0 but stormed back with a six-run sixth inning ... Junior DH **Pat Messner** cracked a two-run double while sophomore Cody Koontz added a two-run single ... GCC will host Waynesburg and W&J in PAC doubleheaders this week.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats bounced back from a pair of losses to Washington & Jefferson on Saturday by defeating the No. 28 ranked Presidents 4-2 on Sunday ... Freshman P **Dave Graff** gave the Tomcats seven strong innings, allowing just one earned run on eight hits ... MIFs **Chad Ulogar** and **Ben Cobler** each recorded three hits, while Cobler doubled and scored two runs ... For the week, Ulogar went 10-of-18 (.556) with four runs scored and two RBIs ... The Tomcats have two non-conference games this week before playing a three-game series with Bethany this weekend.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More had its 10-game winning streak come to an end at the hands of Saint Vincent, but still managed to win the series following a resounding 21-5 victory ... Senior **Brad McIntosh**, who drove in six runs in the series finale, hit .667 for the week with a double, seven RBIs and eight runs scored ... Senior **Brett Walter** hurled a complete-game shutout, yielding five hits and striking out five ... Freshman **Chris Fishburn** drove in seven runs for the week, while hitting .538 ... Thomas More was 12-for-13 on the bases as a team with PAC leader **Dustin Brown** swiping a team-high three bases ... This weekend will mark the final regular season home games for 10 seniors.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents posted a 4-2 record last week to top 20 wins for the fourth straight season ... W&J's nine-member senior class has notched a 108-51 record heading into this week's six-game slate ... Monday, W&J racked up 18 hits during a 16-1 thumping of Westminster ... Senior 1B **Sam Mann** had three hits and three RBI, while senior 2B **Chris Varacallo** collected three hits and two RBI ... W&J blasted four two-run homers in the win ... Senior RHP **John Astfalk** earned the win after limiting the Titans to two hits in five innings ... The Presidents picked up 18 hits again Thursday during its 16-4 victory over La Roche ... Senior SS **Nick Fiorilli** homered and finished with three RBI, while senior OF **Ron Mitko** went 4-for-4 and knocked in three runs ... W&J won 2-of-3 over the weekend against Thiel.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets won two of three games against the Bison over the weekend with senior hurler **Landon Sinclair** claiming both victories ... In the series opener, he tossed a nine-inning complete game with six strikeouts in a 4-1 Waynesburg win ... LF **Ryan Group** led the offense with a 4-for-4 performance, while six other starters collected a hit in the victory ... Freshman **Ryan Lavrusky** suffered the loss in the second game of the series despite surrendering two runs (one earned) in seven innings of work ... Waynesburg pounded out 21 hits in a 12-11 win in the series finale ... Seven Yellow Jackets posted multi-hit games in the contest, including Group and 3B **Dan Novak**, who both collected three RBI.



Westminster Titans

After suffering a 16-1 home loss to W&J Tuesday, Westminster swept a weekend series against Grove City ... In the three-game series vs. GCC, the Titans averaged 12 hits (36) and 10.6 runs (32) per game and combined for eight home runs ... In their previous 12 games since returning from their spring break trip to Florida, they averaged 6.8 hits (82) and three runs (37) per game and six home runs ... Most notable was junior **David Colella**, who had two multiple home run games, including a two-run homer and a grand slam in the series finale to finish the three games batting 6-for-10 with four home runs and 18 RBI ... Winning pitchers included **Andrew Robison** on Friday, **Jake Zatchok** in game one Saturday and **Tony Cunningham** in game two, all pitching at least into the sixth inning.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats went 2-3 last week, including a 10-1 win at Penn State-Fayette and a 6-4 decision over PAC co-leader Thomas More ... Saint Vincent now owns wins over both PAC co-leaders (TMC and W&J) this season ... Junior **Abe Weimer** is batting .366 and has taken over the starting job at third base ... He began the year behind the plate ... Freshman **Jared Lapkowicz** is batting .322 ... **Dave Russell** now has five home runs on the year after hitting one against PSU-Fayette.
