Ott led the Wolverines to a 4-2 week by hitting .571 (12-of-21) with a double, three triples, one home run, seven runs, nine RBIs and two steals. He posted a 1.048 slugging percentage and .609 on-base percentage last week.

Bartholomew needed just 75 pitches to fire a complete game two-hit 1-0 shutout at PAC rival Westminster Saturday. He struck out two and allowed only one runner to reach second, as he posted his third complete game and fourth outing without allowing an earned run in 2006.

Bethany Bison

The hard-charging Bison went a perfect 4-0 last week, including a three-game sweep of Westminster, and are currently riding a six-game winning streak ... Bethany started the week with a 7-3 victory over OAC-leading Otterbein ...

Aaron Meadows went 3-for-3 with a homer and two RBIs, while Milton Joyner allowed just two runs on five hits in 6 2/3 innings in the win ... BC opened the series with Westminster by claming a 1-0 victory behind Brett Bartholomew, who fired a two-hitter for his second shutout of the season ... In game two, the Bison took an 8-3 lead and held off a Titan rally in the seventh ... Ryan Simmons picked up the win , while Ian Edwards notched his fourth save ... In Sunday's finale, a seven-run fifth inning pushed BC to an 11-5 win.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 4-2 last week after being idle during the Easter weekend ... Grove City's 20 wins this year are the second-most in program history ... Senior P Erik Arnesen worked his away into the Grove City record book Sat-

urday ... Arnesen improved to 7-0 by earning the win in Grove City's 11-8 win over W&J ... The seven wins are a single-season school record ... Arnesen struck out six batters, giving him 63 K's this year (also a school record) ... Grove City and W&J have split their last 16 meetings ... Grove City opened the week with a doubleheader sweep of D'Youville ... Junior OF Chris Schwamberger went 4-for-5 in game two ... Thursday night, the Wolverines rallied for an 11-6 win over Lake Erie at Cene Park in Struthers, Ohio.

with four strikeouts in 6.1 innings to pick up the win... Freshman DH Eric Boylan blasted a three-run home run in the top of the fourth to give Thiel a 3-1 lead ... Junior SS Ben Cobler went 1-for-4 with a pair of RBIs ... Senior SP Rich McNeal improved to 3-3 with the game one victory Saturday, allowing one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts ... Junior 3B Shaun Pfeil drove in all three runs in the game one victory Saturday ... Sunday, the Presidents routed Penn State-Altoona, 17-3, in Erie ... Junior LF Nate Hopkins and freshman C Sean Boone each knocked in three runs.
