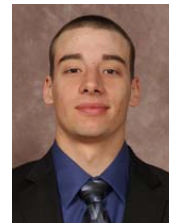

Graber helped lead the Saints to a perfect 4-0 record last week as he batted .714 (10-for-14) with a double, five RBIs and six runs scored. In the Saints' doubleheader sweep of PAC rival Geneva, he was a perfect eight-for-eight with a double, five RBIs and three runs scored with a 1.125 slugging percentage.

Also nominated was junior IF/P **Brad Kubis** of Bethany, freshman 3B **J.R. Willard** of Grove City, senior OF **Zack Galasso** of Saint Vincent, junior OF **Eric Steining** of Thiel, senior SS **Aaron Klinec** of Washington & Jefferson, freshman IF **Joseph Smith** of Waynesburg, and senior 1B **Tim Wiand** of Westminster.

Trushel earned his second weekly PAC honor this season as he posted a pair of complete game victories last week. He allowed just one earned run in 16.0 innings pitched (0.56 ERA), including a two-hit shutout against Westminster for the first shut-out of his career. Trushel also tied a Presidents' single-season record with his seventh complete game and tied a career-high with his eighth victory, as he struck out seven and walked just one vs. the Titans.

Also nominated was freshman **Ryan Meier** of Bethany, junior **Aaron Carmack** of Thomas More, senior **Ben Oviatt** of Waynesburg, and senior **Vince Iosue** of Westminster.



PRESIDENTIAL COMMAND: The Washington & Jefferson Presidents, which moved into the D3Baseball.com national Top 25 poll at #25 last week, are solidly in command of the race for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2012 PAC Baseball Championship Tournament after sweeping second place Westminster in a three game series last weekend.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More went 4-0, including a sweep of Geneva, as senior 1B **Andrew Thole** broke the school career RBI record ... Freshman IF **Joseph Smith** hit .462 (6-for-13) with a team-best 12 RBIs for 3-1 Waynesburg ... **Zack Galasso** led Saint Vincent to a 2-3 week by batting .563 (9-for-16) with three doubles and seven RBIs.

AROUND THE PAC: Thiel P **Bobby Hillier** allowed two runs in a nine-inning complete game win vs. Grove City ... Junior 1B **Tim Wiand** hit .400 (6-for-15) for 1-4 Westminster ... Junior RF **Cameron Jones** posted a .636 on base percentage for 0-4 Grove City ... **Adam Scheiderer** homered and doubled vs. Thomas More last week for 0-3 Geneva.

It was a busy week for the Bison, who opened with splits against Pitt-Greensburg and Mount Aloysius before taking 2 of 3 from Saint Vincent over the weekend ... **Brad Kubis** was 6-for-8 with 7 RBI and picked up the save in a 9-6 win in game 2 at Pitt-Greensburg ... **Derek Miller** was 2-for-4 with a homer and **Harrison Rightmyer** threw four strong innings of relief to lead BC to 9-3 win in game two over Mount Aloysius ... In Sunday's 1st game at Saint Vincent, **Anthony Packer** was 3-for-4 with three RBIs and **Ryan Styche** threw 6 1/3 solid innings in an 11-5 win ... Miller was 3-for-4 with two runs scored in the nightcap and **Ryan Meier** (6 1/3 IP, 2 R, 2 K) and Kubis (2 2/3 IP, 0 R, 2 K) were strong on the hill to lift Bethany to 4-2 victory and the series win.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-19, 8-13 PAC)



Geneva dropped three games at Thomas More over the weekend to fall to 14-19 overall and 8-13 in the PAC ... The Golden Tornadoes surrendered 39 runs in the three game series and pushed 11 across the plate of their own ... The series opened with a solo home run off of the bat of **Mike Jeffreys** and **Adam Scheiderer** added a solo shot of his own in game one ... Scheiderer also put up a three-run double in Geneva's 9-4 loss to the Saints on Saturday ... The Golden Tornadoes will play a non-conference doubleheader at Medaille on Tuesday before closing out the regular season with a three-game series against Waynesburg next weekend.

Grove City Wolverines (5-23, 3-13 PAC)



Grove City went 0-4 in conference play last week ... Saturday, inclement weather cut the Wolverines' doubleheader at Thiel in half ... The doubleheader will be completed Tuesday at 4 p.m. in Greenville ... Junior RF **Cameron Jones** posted a .636 on-base percentage for the week ... Jones and **Zach Struharik** share the team lead with .333 batting averages ... Struharik leads Grove City with 20 runs batted in and 33 total hits ... **Tom Hawley** leads the Wolverines with 20 runs scored ... **Kyle Shock** leads Grove City with a .514 slugging percentage and a .438 on-base percentage ... Grove City hosts Waynesburg in a single game Wednesday before facing W&J this weekend ... Grove City goes to Washington Friday before hosting the Presidents Saturday at 1 p.m. in a doubleheader.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (20-13, 10-10 PAC)



The Bearcats posted a 2-3 record this week against conference opponents Bethany and Westminster ... In game one against Westminster, **Jared Haller** went the distance in the win giving up only two earned runs and striking out three Titans ... Seniors **Erik Fichter** and **Jack Shaffer** and junior **Grant Krally** all recorded two RBI in the contest ... In the game two loss against Westminster, junior **Andrew Kozusko** drove in two in 1-for-3 performance ... In game one against Bethany, senior **Zack Galasso** went 4-for-4 with four RBIs and broke the school's single season doubles record, recording his 14th in the 9-3 win ... Junior Nick Beamenderfer returned from injury Sunday with a 2-for-3 performance in the game one loss ... The single nine-inning game saw a two hit day by **Alonzo Vasquez**.

Thiel Tomcats (14-18, 7-9 PAC)



The Tomcat baseball team finished last week with a 2-3 record dropping their conference record to 7-9 on the season ... After falling in three straight contests to Saint Vincent, and W&J, Thiel stormed back taking two of the first three games of a three game series with Grove City ... In the contest against Saint Vincent, **Ryan Dixon** led the way going 3-for-5 ... In the contests against Grove City, the top three hitters in the Tomcats lineup showed their muscle, as **Doug Farley**, **Eric King**, and **Eric Steininger** each had multiple hits in both contests ... In the first contest against the Wolverines, **Bobby Hillier** pitched his first nine-inning complete game of his career allowing just two earned runs and striking out seven in the 9-4 victory.

Thomas More Saints (22-10, 11-7 PAC)



Thomas More went 4-0 last week, including a three-game sweep of PAC foe Geneva and won its four games by a combined score of 51-16 ... Sophomore 3B **Tyler Graber** led the Saints at the plate as he was 10-for-14 (.714) with a double, five RBIs and six runs scored ... The Saints had four other Saints bat over .500 as senior 1B **Andrew Thole** batted .583, sophomore CF **Cody Makin** batted .563, and junior RF **Ryan Darnier** and sophomore DH **Travis Miller** both batted .500 ... Thole broke the Thomas More career RBI record during the Saints' doubleheader sweep with Geneva ... On the mound, freshman **Tim Baldrick** had an 0.00 ERA as he pitched five shutout innings and gave up five hits and struck out three, while senior **Aaron Carmack** had a 1.50 ERA as he pitched six innings and gave up one run.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (24-4, 15-2 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson won all five of its PAC games last week, improving its record to 24-4 overall and 15-2 in PAC play ... The Presidents entered the national rankings as the 25th-ranked squad in the D3baseball.com poll for the first time since 2010 ... W&J has won eight-straight conference games for the first time since that 2010 season when it claimed nine in a row ... Sophomore RF **Josh Staniscia** pounded out three hits and scored a trio of runs during W&J's sweep of Thiel ... The Presidents swept Westminster for the third-straight season ... Senior RHP **Dave Trushel** earned a pair of complete-game victories, including his first career shutout against Westminster on Sunday ... He upped his season record to 8-1 and now has seven complete games this spring, tying the W&J single-season record.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (19-14, 8-9 PAC)



Waynesburg went 3-1 this past week and swept an important home PAC doubleheader with Grove City on April 25 ... The Jackets kept things rolling with a 13-5 non-PAC win during the opening game of a doubleheader at Penn State Altoona Friday ...
