Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Sophomore 1B **Sam Mann's** two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth in game two helped the Presidents earn a baseball split with Hiram Tuesday ... W&J jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the second inning of game one as freshman DH **Ryan Gregg** singled in one run and sophomore RF **Ron Mitko** scored the second run after a Terrier error ... The Presidents reclaimed a 5-4 lead in the fourth after a two-run double by sophomore SS **Nick Fiorilli** ... Fiorilli led the W&J lineup with two hits and two RBI ... The Presidents trailed 2-1 heading into the bottom of the sixth of the nightcap, but sophomore 3B **Shaun Pfeil** reached on an error to set up Mann ... Sophomore 2B **Chris Varacallo** also added a three-run triple during the rally.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City played only one official game last week, a rain-shortened 10-5 loss to Penn State-Behrend last Wednesday ... **Michael Busin** homered for the Wolverines while **Jonathan Mycyk** doubled ... **Mike Ritter**, Busin and **Ryan Jones** all had two hits ... **Mike Gundy** took the loss for Grove City ... **Jarrett Wiggers** allowed two runs in four innings of relief work ... The game was called with one out in the top of the ninth ... Against Thiel Friday afternoon, rain halted the game prior to the top of the sixth inning ... The game will be completed prior to the start of the teams' scheduled doubleheader ... Grove City can still qualify for the PAC Tournament by sweeping both Thiel and Waynesburg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College baseball team was rained out of each of its games this week against Bethany ... The Yellow Jackets return to the diamond this week when they play three-game series against the Bison and the Wolverines of Grove City.

Thiel Tomcats

Due to poor weather, the Tomcats managed to get in only one game last week, a 21-6 rout of Pitt-Greensburg Monday ... Thiel's three-game series against Grove City was cut short Friday after five innings and will resume Tuesday ... The Tomcats had their highest offensive output of the against UP-G, putting together 20 hits, including 11 extra-base hits ... Senior LF **Keith Jackson** left his usual spot on the mound to make a start in the outfield, his third such start of the season ... He paced Thiel offensively, going 4-for-6 with a pair of two-run home runs, four RBIs and three runs scored ... Junior 3B **Bob Flukas** and sophomore SS **Ben Cobler** each went 3-for-4 with a home run and four RBIs.
