Grove City senior **Kyle Silk** fired a 2-0 five-hit shutout vs. Waynesburg ... **AJ Kavinsky** went 3-for-5 for Saint Vincent in an 8-5 road win at Bethany ... Freshman P **Zach Kreke** posted a pair of complete game wins for Waynesburg.
