CF Tyler Dillinger was 3-for-5 with three runs scored and LF Mark Cummings finished the twinbill 4-for-6 with five RBIs and three runs ... The Bison dropped the opener of the Westminster series 10-6 on the road Friday, despite big days from 1B Nate Tieman (3-4, two RBIs, two runs) and RF Mike Pegg (2-4, two RBIs).

Phil Shallenberger came up big twice against Westminster in a pair of victories on Tuesday before Jon Bushmire pulled off the walk-off magic on Friday as Geneva rallied to beat Waynesburg to move its record to 14-17 on the season ... The Golden Tornadoes had their doubleheader with Waynesburg washed out on Saturday and rescheduled for Tuesday. Geneva will play five PAC games this week to close out the regular season.

Grove City Wolverines (14-14, 7-4 PAC)

Grove City highlighted a busy week by sweeping a PAC

doubleheader with visiting Thiel Tuesday at Jack Behringer Field, 8-1 and 10-4 ... Dan Quirk went 3-for-3 in the opener while in Game Two, the Wolverines used a seven-run fifth inning to break the game open ... GCC left just three runners on base in the nightcap ... Monday at Geneva, SS Scott Moran went 3-for-5 with a homer and four runs scored in a 12-11 setback ... Freshman P Erick Locker started and pitched five innings ... He allowed three runs ... Thomas More took all three games this weekend from Grove City, including a 15-7 win Saturday ... GCC outhit the Saints 16-15 Saturday ... Grove City is now 10-2 this year when collecting more hits in a game than the opposition ... The Wolverines visit Thiel Wednesday and will face W&J this weekend.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-16)

After opening the week with a dramatic victory Bethany, the Bearcats ended the week on a five-game losing skid ... In the Bethany contest, the Bearcats trailed 6-2 in the fifth, before scoring two in the bottom of the seventh for the win, sealed by Adam Miller's RBI walk-off single ... The win was the high point of the week for SVC, as the Bearcat pitching staff was battered for 45 runs in five straight losses, including a 9-7 setback at Franciscan Friday and a three-game weekend sweep at the hands of W&J (15-2, 10-3, 11-8) ... Miller enjoyed a stellar week for the Bearcats, going 10-for-15 in the six games, with 10 RBIs and five runs scored ... He hit his second homer of the week, a grand slam, to give the Bearcats a shortlived 8-6 lead in the eighth inning in Sunday's defeat to Washington & Jefferson.

Freshman P Cody Northcott also turned in a solid performance, but couldn't come up with the win in a 6-5 loss to Allegheny Sunday ... Northcott struck out eight and walked two in 6 1/3 innings of work ... Senior 1B Justin Scarpitti wielded a hot bat last week, pacing the team with a .529 BA (9-for-17) and a slugging percentage of .706 ... "Scarps" hit a threerun homer vs. Allegheny.

Thomas More Saints (21-11, 9-2 PAC)



The Saints went 4-1 last week, all in PAC action

as they split a doubleheader with PAC-leading W&J and swept a three-game PAC series at Grove City ... Junior 3B Sam Schmeltzer had a good week at the plate as he batted .333 (6for-18) with two home runs, two doubles, 12 RBIs and six runs scored ... On the mound last week, freshman Grant Lewis went 2-0 with a 3.75 earned run average as he pitched 12 innings giving up five runs (all earned) on 15 hits and striking out four ... For the season, the Saints are led offensively by junior LF Max Robbins, who is batting .481 (52-for-108) with 15 doubles, 39 RBIs and 34 runs scored ... Sophomore P Paul Uhl leads the Saints' pitching staff with a 1.41 ERA and an 8-1 record as he has pitched 51 innings, giving up 15 runs (eight earned) on 34 hits and striking out 45.

Senior RHP Jim Pasquine earned his first victory of the season in game one versus SVC after pitching four innings and allowing two runs on four hits ... Senior RHP Mitch McClay fired a complete game in the second contest and struck out six Bearcats ... Sophomore 2B Aaron Klinec smacked his first career home run and batted .444 for the week ... W&J will honor the careers of 13 players Saturday prior to the DH with Grove City.
